It is in encounters with others

and be prepared to even get dirty, perhaps take risks.

Truly helping someone means being willing to feel the weight of another's pain.

Only when we recognize that we ourselves are the wounded man can we truly feel compassion.

God of grace, thank you for inviting me To live my vocation to teaching By serving as a Viatorian educator Who strives to teach the faith well.


May this ministry In the classroom and beyond Clarify and strengthen My students' understanding Of their gifts, talents, and passions And of Your invitation To put divine love in motion.








Dear Friends of St. Patrick Parish,


