



Brothers, sisters ... I speak to you, especially to those who no longer believe, no longer hope, no longer pray, because they think God has left. To those who are fed up with scandals, with misused power, with the silence of a Church that sometimes seems more like a palace than a home. I, too, was angry with God. I, too, saw good people die, children suffer, grandparents cry without medicine. And yes, ... there were days when I prayed and only felt an echo.



But then I discovered something: God doesn't shout.

God whispers. And sometimes he whispers from the mud, from pain, from a grandmother who feeds you without having anything. I don't come to offer you perfect faith. I come to tell you that faith is a walk with stones, puddles, and unexpected hugs.

I'm not asking you to believe in everything. I'm asking you not to close the door. Give a chance to the God who waits for you without judgment. I'm just a priest who saw God in the smile of a woman who lost her son ... and yet she cooked for others. That changed me.

So if you're broken, if you don't believe, if you're tired of the lies, ... come anyway. With your anger, your doubt, your dirty backpack. No one here will ask you for a VIP card. Because this Church, as long as I breathe, will be a home for the homeless, and a rest for the weary. God doesn't need soldiers. He needs brothers and sisters. And you, yes you ... are one of them.

Hermanos, hermanas... Me dirijo a ustedes, especialmente a quienes ya no creen, ya no esperan, ya no rezan, porque creen que Dios se ha ido. Pero entonces descubrí algo: Dios no grita. Dios susurra. Y a veces susurra desde el barro, desde el dolor, desde una abuela que te alimenta sin tener nada. No vengo a ofrecerles una fe perfecta. Vengo a decirles que la fe es un caminar entre piedras, charcos y abrazos inesperados.

No les pido que crean en todo. Les pido que no cierren la puerta. Denle una oportunidad a Dios, que los espera sin juzgarlos. Solo soy un sacerdote que vio a Dios en la sonrisa de una mujer que perdió a su hijo... y aun así, cocinó para otros. Eso me cambió.



Así que, si están destrozados, si no creen, si están cansados de las mentiras... vengan de todos modos. Con su ira, sus dudas, su mochila sucia. Aquí nadie les pedirá una tarjeta VIP. Porque esta Iglesia, mientras yo viva, será un hogar para los sin techo y un descanso para los cansados. Dios no necesita soldados. Necesita hermanos y hermanas. Y tú, sí, tú... eres uno de ellos.
