What is the joy that the Christian is called to live and bear witness to? It is the joy that comes from the closeness of God, from God's presence in our lives.


Jesus has come to bring joy to all people for all time.

No! It is not that, but a joy already real and tangible now, because Jesus himself is our joy, and with Jesus joy finds its home.


