Brothers and Sisters,

Next Sunday Bishop Rhoades will be offering Mass at our parish at 10:00am. I encourage everyone to attend. This is a big event for us, as he is the point of unity and the chief priest in our diocese. When the bishop celebrates Mass, the liturgy is elevated from when a priest offers the Mass.

At the opening of Mass, the bishop uses the greeting "Peace be with you" to which we all respond, "and with your spirit." During the liturgy of the Word, after the Gospel is proclaimed, the people **remain standing**, and the book of the Gospels is brought to the bishop. He kisses the Gospels, as they contain the real presence of Christ, and blesses the people with the book. Finally, at the end of Mass, the bishop concludes with the following dismissal:

Bishop: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

All: Who made heaven and earth.

Bishop: Blessed be the name of the Lord.

All: Now and for ever.

Bishop: May almighty God bless you, The **Father**, ✠ and the **Son**, ✠ and the Holy ✠ **Spirit**.

All: Amen.

These changes are rooted in the church's theology of Holy Orders. The bishop has the fullness of orders, and therefore the fullness of Christ's priesthood, whereas a priest is a co-worker of the bishop, and through the bishop participates in Christ's priesthood. This is why the bishop uses Christ's words to greet the congregation whereas a priest uses a different scriptural greeting. Similarly, after the Gospel, the bishop blesses the people with the book of the Gospel because he has the fullness of orders (priests give blessings as co-workers of the bishop). Finally, the bishop's blessing at the end of Mass is related to the fullness of his orders, mirroring the abundance of blessing that Christ himself pours out on the Church. His triple sign of the cross signifies the totality of the Trinity and is a visible manifestation of his care for his flock.

I hope many of you will attend this special occasion as we welcome our chief shepherd to our parish to lead us in worship.

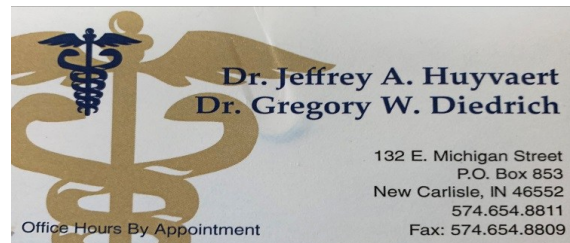
