From the Pastor

Brothers and Sisters,

As you can see, we have updated the look of the bulletin. I am hoping this new look will make it easier to find information and give our bulletin a more professional look and feel. Of course, I am open to your feedback. I want this bulletin to be an effective tool for communicating with parishioners.

This week we celebrate the 250th birthday of our nation. This is not only an opportunity for us to celebrate with cookouts and fireworks, but to understand how blessed we are to live in the United States of America. While the nation does not have a state sponsored religion, the founding Fathers recognized that our constitution relies on Christian principles. George Washington, in his first inaugural address, said "The propitious [favorable] smiles of Heaven can never be expected on a nation that disregards the eternal rules of right and order which Heaven itself has ordained." Our second president, John Adams, wrote, "We have no government armed with power capable of contending with human passions unbridled by morality and religion. Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other." In other words, the early fathers recognized that our nation's success was linked to something greater than the Constitution, namely our religious and moral values. Without them, no nation can sustain itself, as every nation is dependent on God.

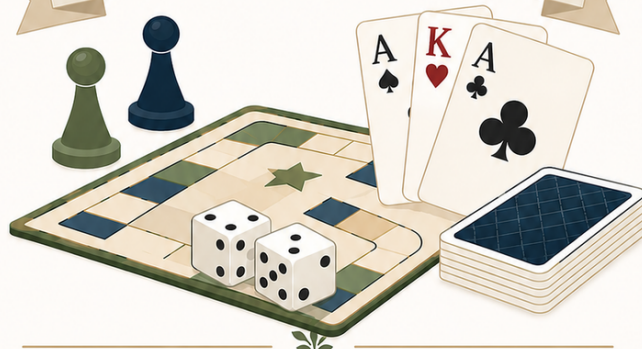
