From the Pastor

Brothers and Sisters,

When we approach the altar, we participate in the one, perfect sacrifice of Christ that transcends time and space. Within this sacred action, the Church maintains the ancient practice of the Mass Intention, where the priest applies the fruit of the Eucharist to a particular person or need. While the Mass is always offered for the salvation of the world, a specific intention allows us to direct the infinite graces of the sacrifice toward a specific member of the Body of Christ, living or deceased.

We must be careful not to view this as a transactional or juridical exchange. Although it is customary to offer a small stipend, we cannot purchase grace, nor is the Mass a commodity. Rather, when we request an intention, we are making a spiritual offering. We are uniting our own hearts and intercessions to the offering of Jesus Christ. Whether we are praying for the repose of a soul of a loved one, the healing of a friend, or in thanksgiving for a birthday or anniversary, we are placing that person into the very heart of the Paschal Mystery.

Theologically, this is rooted in our belief in the Communion of Saints. We believe our prayers for one another, especially at the moment of Consecration, have real efficacy. It is a profound act of mercy to provide a person with the spiritual gift of the Eucharist, petitioning God to unite them more closely to Himself. It is a way of saying that no one is forgotten in the eyes of the Father, who is always seeking an opportunity to reveal His mercy.

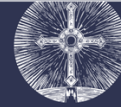
