From the Pastor

Brothers and Sisters,

Next week, on September 8, we celebrate the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To celebrate as a community, we will have a free parish breakfast sponsored by the Legion of Mary on September 6th after the 10:00 a.m. Mass. Please join us for food and fellowship as we honor Mary (and then, of course, go home and honor her by cheering on her football team in their season opener)!

As we prepare to celebrate the nativity of Mary, it is also important to consider her role in our lives. Oftentimes, we Catholics are accused of worshipping Mary. This, of course, is a false accusation. Worship (*latria*) is due to God alone. *Latria* is the Latin term for supreme worship or adoration, which we give only to God. *Latria* is based on God's uncreated, infinite nature and sovereignty. *Latria* is not given to Mary and the saints as we do not worship them. But we do honor them. The honor we give them is denoted by the Latin term *dulia*. *Dulia* recognizes God's grace reflected in created beings.

Unlike *latria*, *dulia* does not involve sacrificial worship. It involves intercessory prayer, honor, and the remembering of exemplary lives. The highest form of *dulia*, called *hyperdulia*, is given to Mary. Of all people, she lived the life most perfectly united to the life of her Son. This is why we give her the highest honor – not sacrificial worship, but honor. We do this not by offering Mass to her (which would be *latria*), but by rejoicing in her Son with her.

It is important that such honor is celebrated not only privately, but communally as well. Just as we may honor a friend or loved one by publicly sharing their joys (birthdays, anniversaries, etc.) in public celebrations, so too do we honor the saints. And so, as we prepare to celebrate the birth of Mary, I hope that our celebration as a community will bring us to a greater appreciation of all that she has done for us. From her fiat on earth to her queenship in heaven, she is constantly pointing us to a deeper relationship with Christ. And for that, we can honor her and, with her, give worship to her Son.
