From the Pastor

Brothers and Sisters,

On Wednesday, Pope Leo XIV used his weekly audience to address the dignity of the human person. It is a topic I have been addressing in one of my courses at Holy Cross College called Christ, Church, and the Marketplace. The dignity of the human person must be understood as more than a collective dignity of the human species. For the Church teaches that each individual person was created with a unique dignity. That is to say, each person is a unique, unrepeatable instance of God's creative love.

The respect for the dignity of the human person is the foundation of all Catholic Social Teaching. Each person has an ontological dignity. This ontological dignity is grounded in the teaching that every person is made in God's image. Our ontological dignity gives rise to a second dignity, our moral dignity.

The moral dignity of the human person refers to how the person uses free will. Free will is not the ability to do whatever we want, but the faculty that allows us to choose to do what is truly good. Acting in accord with a well-formed conscience allows a person's moral dignity to increase. On the other hand, choosing to act in a manner that is immoral is not an exercise of free will, but an abuse of the faculty that is intended to point us to the good. Such abuse of free will causes a person's moral dignity to become compromised or diminished.

In order to exercise our free will and increase our dignity, Pope Leo reminded the audience of the need to form their consciences. In our cultural context where we are often divided on moral issues, this call seems all the more prescient. And it seems to me it would be a good topic for adult faith formation, as well as for youth catechesis. If this is a topic of interest, please let me know how you think we could best accomplish the task of learning to form our conscience.
