Brothers and Sisters,

After the listening session a few weeks ago, I have been praying over how we as a parish can become more intentional in our discipleship. Being an intentional disciple is more than simply showing up at Mass and following a set of rules. It is about forming a personal relationship with Jesus Christ that becomes the basis for all our activities in life.

In order to help us deepen our relationship with Christ both personally and communally, I am proposing we do a parish book study. I would like to use the book *Forming Intentional Disciples* by Sherry Weddell and hope to have a majority of the parish read this book. Sherry Weddell's book has been influential in my life as a priest, and more importantly as a disciple of Jesus Christ. Sherry discusses the need for all disciples to form personal relationships with Jesus Christ, while also noting that many Catholics do not know how to do this. Her book, and the accompanying workbook, (which was written by Ximena Debroek, with whom I worked when I was in Baltimore) are designed to help Catholics develop, deepen and articulate their relationship with Jesus Christ. The book and workbook together can be purchased for around \$20.

My vision for this book study is that parishioners would form small study groups (around 4-8 people) that could work through the material at their own pace (perhaps beginning in November or Advent). The small groups can be put together at random, or can be targeted groups (for example, maybe our young adults want to form a group, or maybe a mother's group may want to work through this together) or even prayer/faith groups that already exist.

In order to make this work, I will need people to step up and volunteer to be a group leader (yes, that means you). Leaders do not need to be theologically trained. They simply need to be willing to facilitate when and where the group will meet. Then the group can work through the book together.

Groups could meet at the homes of one or more of the members, at a restaurant, coffee shop, etc. or even virtually. The idea is to create fellowship while also deepening our lives of faith. It is to encounter Christ Jesus and share our encounter with each other.

If you would like to either be a leader for a small group, or form a targeted small group, or are interested in joining a small group to work though this book, please let me know. I hope this effort will find some momentum and that this book study will help us to deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ.




