Brothers and Sisters,

As you know, one of my concerns is that as Catholics we often are not given the tools necessary to think about and articulate our relationship with Christ, must less share it with others. I am hoping that our parish reading of *Forming Intentional Disicples* will be fruitful in helping our parish with this. I want to explain why this is so important to me, and I believe to us as a parish.

As I write this, I just came out of our first session with Bishop Rhoades on the upcoming Diocesan Synod. The Bishop mentioned the need to read the signs of the times. On in individual level, that means looking at the particular circumstances of my life, and asking who the Lord is calling me to be. What are the gifts God has given me? How can I use those in the particular circumstance of my life? Where do I need assistance, and who has the gifts necessary to assist me?

As we read through this book in small groups, I hope that each group will be able to help its members grow into the unique disciples that the Lord is calling each member to be. This may mean helping others to see the giftedness they did not know they possessed, or to help them understand their lives in a new, hope filled way. When we have the necessary tools, we can build up the Kingdom of God in our midst.

I had a powerful experience of this about two weeks ago. I was at wits end with one of my classes. After class, I went to the chapel to pray. I was asking God if anything I did mattered to anyone, or if I was trying to be someone I was not (a teacher). At the end of my prayer, I checked my phone, and saw an email from a former student. The student told me that my course changed the way he thinks about his life - rather than asking who he wants to be, who does God want me to be. He wrote me because he wanted to talk with me in greater detail about understanding God's will in his life. And at the same time, he (without knowing) was the voice of God telling me to stop moping and get back to work!

That was a much needed affirmation, especially after a frustrating day in the classroom. This former student affirmed gifts in me that I was doubting in myself. He was evangelizing me. In other words, evangelization is not simply walking up to someone and asking them if they accept Jesus as their personal Lord and savior. In many cases, it begins with helping people see that God has given them gifts that need to be put to use. Our task in evangelization is to help people understand the particulars that will allow them to more fully actualize the person God is calling them to be.

I hope this resonates with you, and that you will participate in a book study group. I hope that by participating in the group, you will have a better understanding of your relationship with Christ, and will help others in your group better understand their relationship with Christ, so that we can all better actualize who God is calling us to be.


