#### Second Sunday of Advent — December 7, 2025

Brothers and Sisters,

The second week of Advent focuses on peace. Peace is an essential aspect of our faith. Establishing peace is the goal sacrificial acts (trust me, I literally did a dissertation on this), and the Eucharist is the sacrifice that brings about true peace.

This true peace differs from our worldly notions of peace. Hence Jesus says "Peace I leave you, my peace I give you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you" (John 14:27). The peace that Jesus gives us is true peace. It stands in contrast to the peace the world gives. The world often establishes peace by seeking a scapegoat to blame for all discord, and then it violently expels the scapegoat to bring about peace. But Jesus does not expel; rather, he gathers all things, uniting them to himself. This union with him brings about true peace; it is his peace.

This peace requires conversion on our part. He offers us his peace, but he does not offer it as the world does. He does not use force to subdue us. Instead, he teaches us his ways, so that we may enter into an authentic union with him.

During Advent, we prepare for Christ's second coming by diligently working to form a greater union with him. We spend more time in focused and intentional prayer, so that we can know him better. And with this deeper knowledge of Christ, we seek ways to live our lives for the good of others. In so doing, our lives become sacrificial, and we become more closely united with Christ whose life was sacrificial. And ultimately, we experience his peace.




