Brothers and Sisters,

Last week the priests who work in parishes had our consultation phase to prepare for the Diocesan Synod. Most of us stated that we went into the process with low expectations (and I'll admit to being one of them). However, at the end of the process, most of us were very excited, optimistic and even rejuvenated.

I am hoping we will have a similar experience on the parish level as well. Next week we will begin our prayerful opening at the weekend Masses. Every parishioner who is confirmation age and older is asked to participate. You will be given a reflection booklet and asked to pray with it on a daily basis. There are a series of questions that you are asked to consider. Please do not do this in the haphazard manner that my students do their homework. Instead, take 5-10 minutes in serious quiet prayer. Maybe light a candle (but don't burn your house down). Then look at the book, and pray over the questions, noting what the Holy Spirit is bring to your mind. Take notes each day, and feel free to revisit questions on different days.

One of the things I found fruitful about the process was not only the opportunity to think about St. Stanislaus Kostka, but to hear from other priests in the diocese, and the way in which we were able to learn from each other and assist each other in understanding how the Holy Spirit is calling us to mission.

One of the fruits that we are already seeing is that of priests finding ways to collaborate. As parish priests, we do not see our brothers in ministry as much as we probably should. And the last thing any of us wants to do is to be a bother to brother priest, as we know the demands we all face already. But in less than 1 week, I have already seen priests reaching out to each other in greater charity, trying to find ways to share resources. In fact, I even spearheaded a small effort amongst some South Bend area priests to help prepare for the parish consultations.

One concern that was raised by one of my brother priests was that while we priests had to attend our sessions, we cannot enforce the laity to participate. He put it bluntly saying that he could have a sign that the Beatific Vision would be arriving at 7:00 pm and still only three people would show up. While I understand that many are busy, I am hopeful that everyone who is confirmation age (roughly 13) and older will participate. On a personal level, I believe this will also help us as we strive to become more intentional in our discipleship and deepen our relationship with the Lord.
