

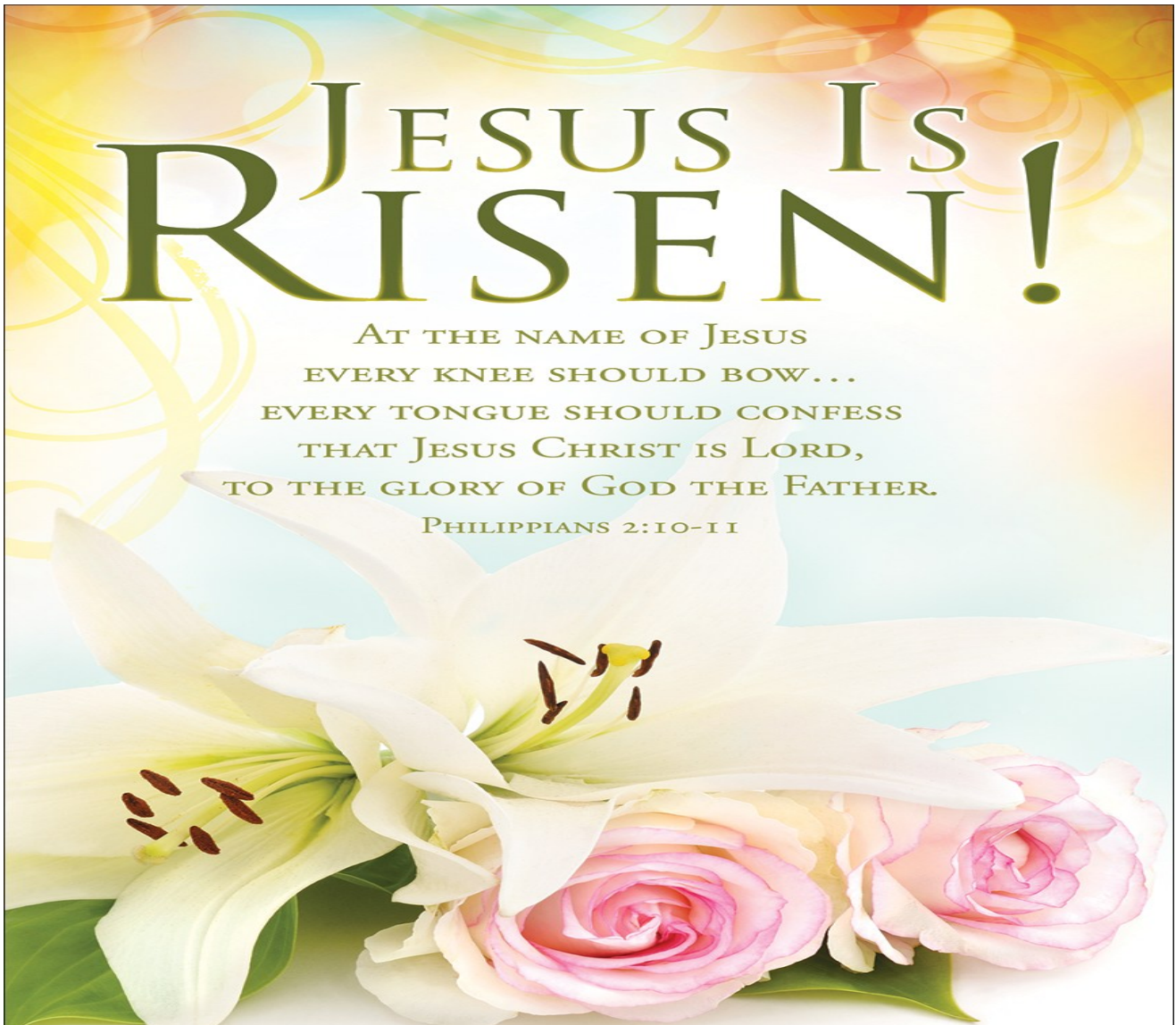

Easter Sunday - April 5, 2026

Alleluia! He is Risen!

Brothers and sisters,

In a tension-filled Jerusalem our savior, Jesus Christ, was crucified and died. Three days later, he rose from the dead, definitively revealing that God does not respond to human sin with violence and vengeance, but with mercy. This is the Good News. It is the Easter message we share with the world.

Today our society is polarized and violence is escalating. As Christians we are called to respond with the same mercy and peace modeled for us by Christ for his peace is true peace. Every week at Mass we hear the words of Jesus recorded in John's Gospel, "Peace, I leave you, my peace I give you" (John 14:27). The quote continues "Not as the world gives do I give it to you."

The world often tries to establish peace by escalating violence. Whether it is one nation waging war against another to ensure long-term peace, or whether it is one person seeking revenge for an offense, the world uses violence and vengeance to establish peace. Even worse, the world attributes such violence to God.

Jesus establishes true peace through mercy and forgiveness. Humanity did the worst thing it could possibly be due to God by falsely condemning and killing Him. God did not respond to this greatest offense by escalating the violence; he did not throw lightning bolts or send legions of angels to destroy humanity. In fact, he didn't even ask Peter to submit his resignation as an Apostle by 6:00pm. Rather, he responded with mercy.

This is the Good News of Easter. God responds to human sin with mercy and forgiveness. Our Easter Octave concludes next weekend with Divine Mercy Sunday. This celebration is one of great rejoicing, as we celebrate the peace offered to us by Christ. But it also moves us to action. We are called to enter into union with Christ by offering that same peace, that same mercy and forgiveness to others. So, as we celebrate and sing Alleluias, let us be mindful to also unite ourselves to Christ by offering his peace and mercy to those who have offended us. For in doing so, we move from death into life.

APRIL IS CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH



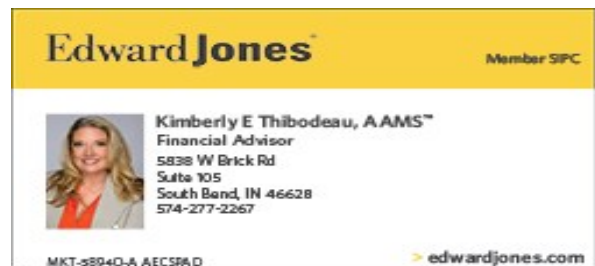
