Pentecost Sunday - May 24, 2026

Brothers and Sisters,

Today we celebrate Pentecost. Our celebration recalls a past event in which the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, but it also beckons us to consider the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives today.

Last week I asked everyone to pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal the gifts given to you, and to ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in discerning how these gifts are to be used to serve others. I hope you did that. Because we now enter the next phase of our discipleship, in which we open ourselves to receiving what God has revealed and acting upon it. After the Apostles opened themselves to the reception of the Holy Spirit, they were able to carry out the mission left to them by Christ. If we wish to be authentic disciples, we too must carry out the mission given to us by Christ. This is more than carrying out religious obligations, it is about dedicating our lives to service of God.

Next week we will be having a ministries fair in the Parish Hall immediately following each Mass. I ask that no one leave Mass with excuses as to why you cannot participate in the life of the parish. Rather, I ask everyone to commit to deepening their discipleship by attending the ministries fair. But do not think of this as a recruitment tool for parish groups (although you can learn more about our needs). Rather, think about this in terms of what it means to be an intentional disciple.

Disciples cannot be lukewarm, such discipleship will be rejected by Christ (Rev 3:15-16). Discipleship is a way of life that requires us to give, not most things, but everything to Christ. If we are to truly serve him, we have to be in constant dialogue with him. We must discern how he is calling us to act at every particular moment of our lives. If we do this, we will not be "spit out" (Rev 3:16) by Christ, but rather we will hear the Lord say "Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities. Come, share your master's joy" (Matt 25:23).

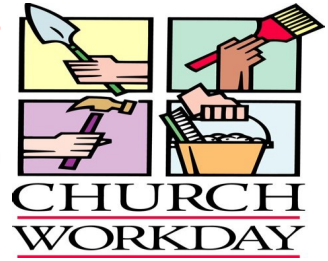
