Seventh Sunday of Easter - May 17, 2026

Brothers and Sisters,

This week we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. In most of the world it is celebrated on the Thursday in the 6th week of Easter. But many dioceses in the US, including our own, have moved it to Sunday.

Between the Ascension and Pentecost it is common to pray a novena to the Holy Spirit (or in our case make a 6-day devotion). During this time we recall the period in which the disciples awaited the coming of the Advocate - the Holy Spirit. This year in particular, I ask you to pray about the gifts that the Holy Spirit has given you to advance the mission of the Church. After Pentecost, we will be having a (long overdue) ministries fair, in which we ask people to use the gifts given them by the Holy Spirit to serve the needs of our parish. Some of our greatest needs are liturgical, especially with Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (which would allow us to make the chalice available, as "Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it takes place under both kinds" (GIRM 281). Other liturgical needs include Altar Servers, lectors (the readers at Mass), and greeters/ushers.

In addition to liturgical needs, there are other needs that your gifts may fulfill. We are starting a Garden Club, and many people have expressed interest in that. We have a group of people who make rosaries. We also have our women's Altar Rosary Society, our Men's Ushers Club and our Legion of Mary, all of which actively assist the parish. I am also hoping to find some youth in the Parish willing to help with social media (Insta, Tik-Tok, etc. – and yes, I think this needs to be led by our youth). In addition, we need people to assist with Money Counting, and I am in need of someone willing to assist our Parish Council with taking minutes.

So please, use this next week to pray to the Holy Spirit and discern how the gifts that you have been given can be used to participate in the Church's mission to "make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19).

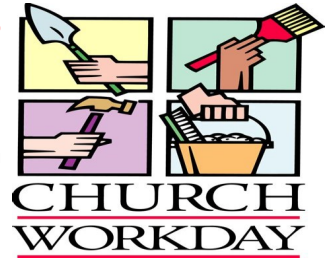

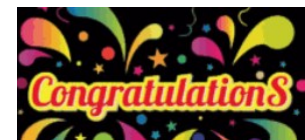
