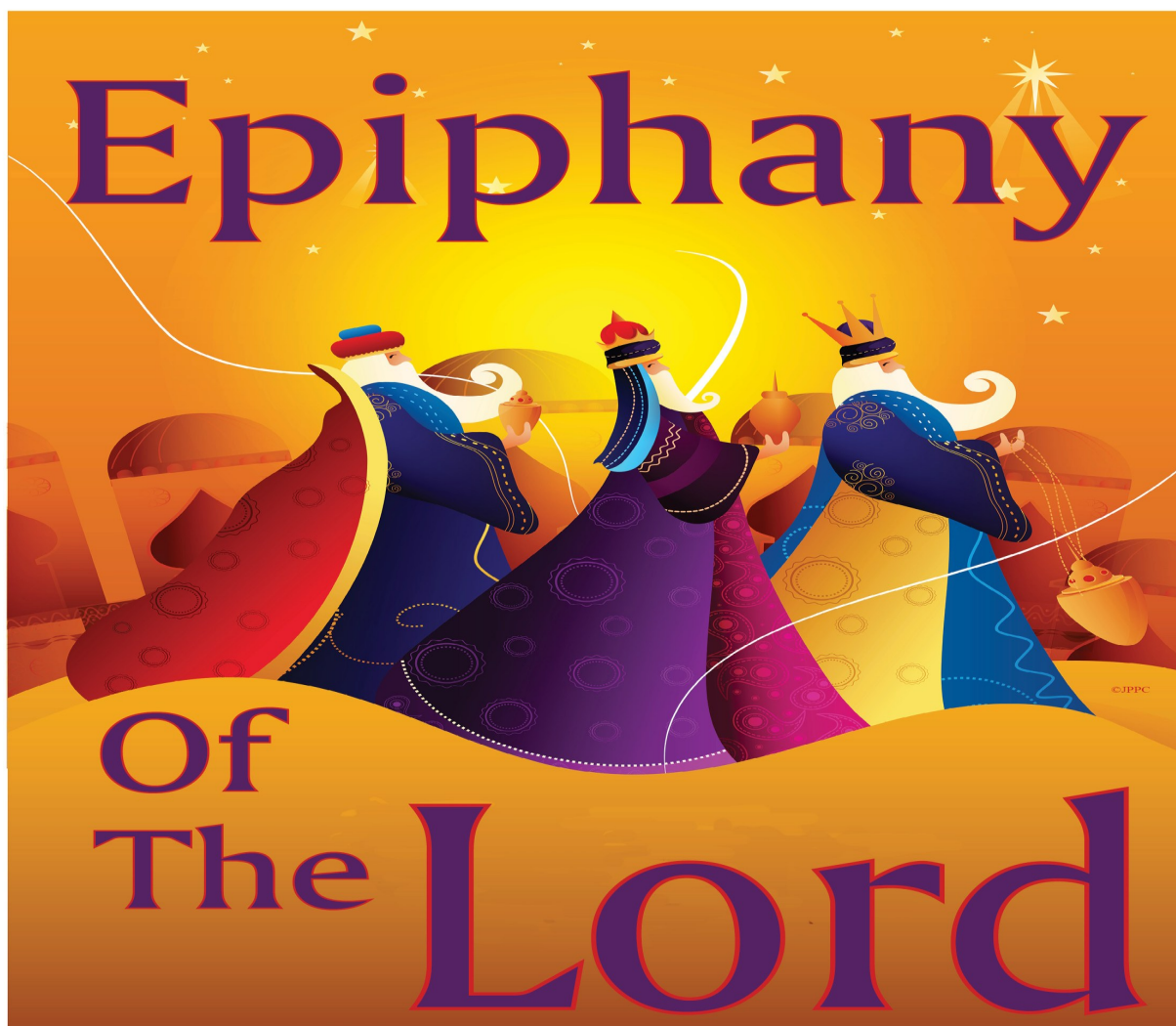

The Epiphany of the Lord—January 4, 2026

Brothers and Sisters,

Happy New Year!

I hope that everyone had blessed celebrations for the holidays. For me it was a little rough, as we learned this week that my mom's cancer has returned. So I ask for your prayers for her recovery this year.

Today we celebrate the epiphany, the day in which the birth of the Lord was made to all nations. We hear of three Magi who learn of the birth of a new king, and make a grueling trek to visit the new king and pay him homage.

The story of the Magi is a great story of conversion. The Magi were not of Jewish origin, as were the shepherds to whom the Angels announced the birth Christ and Peace to men of good will. The Magi were of pagan origin. And in their day, there were numerous kings. And yet it was not to any of those kings that they traveled, but to the true king, Jesus Christ. That is to say, they recognized he was not just one king among many, but he was The King, the Messiah. And so they took upon themselves the grueling trek to visit this king, and place their gifts at his feet, at his service.

As Christians, we recognize that Jesus is not merely a king, but The King. We recognize that, like the Magi, we must place our gifts as his service. The way in which we do this differs from person to person, as we each have unique gifts. The gifts the Magi brought were gold, frankincense and myrrh. These acknowledge that Jesus is king, priest and prophet. Our gifts must likewise be used to witness that Jesus is king, priest and prophet. The Magi did this and were changed, converted by the experience, as such they went home by a different route. We too must be changed by our encounter with Christ, by our relationship with him. Being changed, we must "leave by a different route." That is to say we need to act differently. For once we have encountered Christ, we cannot possibly act the same as we did before.
