Brothers and Sisters,

At priest gatherings, it is not uncommon for someone to lament that many Catholics do not know about Mass intentions. In thinking about this, I realized that I learned about Mass intentions in my first job when I was 13 (I worked answering phones in our parish office), but I never understood them until I entered seminary. While some generations of Catholics grew up with “Mass intentions” and “stipends” being part of their regular vocabulary, many generations (and perhaps even most of those alive now) did not. So let me explain briefly what Mass intentions and Mass stipends are.

It is likely that you have heard prayers stating that the Mass is offered “for the repose of the soul of...” or “for the intentions of...” someone. These are called Mass intentions. That is not to say that the person being prayed for is the only one who is being remembered or benefiting from the Mass. Rather, they are being remembered in a particular way so that graces of the Mass are applied to their specific needs. A Mass intention can be applied to anyone, living or dead. Most frequently Mass intentions are for someone who has died, or for intentions such as healing, thanksgiving, or guidance or for special occasions such as birthdays and anniversaries.

Mass intentions are usually accompanied by a Mass stipend. A Mass stipend is a free-will offering given by a person who requests that a priest offer a Mass for a specific intention. The offering is not a price for the Mass, as the grace of the Mass is priceless and cannot be bought or sold. Rather, it is a gift, a way of participating in the Church’s sacrificial offering. Historically it was how priests were paid and still is in some parts of the world.

The suggested offering for a Mass intention in our diocese is \$10, though a person may give, or nothing at all, according to their means. The Church emphasizes that no one will ever be denied Mass intention due to inability to offer a stipend.

Each intention is assigned to a specific Mass, and only one intention may be offered per Mass, with rare exceptions. It is one way that we, as a community, lift one another up in prayer in the most powerful way possible – through the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

If you wish to request a Mass for yourself, a loved one, or for a special intention, please contact Paula at the parish office. You’ll be asked to provide the name(s) and the date(s) you prefer, and we will do our best to accommodate your request.

Let us continue to pray for one another and to treasure the graces given to us whenever we celebrate Mass.
