

### 3-day class- Acrylic Painting Materials with Joan Fullerton

**Brushes:** Inexpensive 2” hardware brush and a 1” synthetic flat brush, no need for expensive brushes. A chip brush is great!



**Brayer (printmaking roller, hard rubber) \$11 on Amazon**



For **PAINT** prefer **FLUID ACRYLICS**, a handful of colors plus black, white and Titan Buff. My favorites: **Azo Gold, Turquoise (Phthalo), Quinacridone Crimson, Cobalt Blue, Green Gold, Yellow Ochre, Yellow Light, Pyrrole Orange, Oxide Green, Naphthol Red, Red Oxide, Titan Green Pale and Raw Umber; feel free to bring YOUR favorites! Heavy Body paint can be used if that is what you have.**

**One 1oz. bottle (Pointy top) of High Flow paint to be used in the small spray bottle.**

**5-6 substrates of your choice: 140 lb. or 300 lb. watercolor paper and/or stretched canvas, board and/or cradled wood panels.**

**Small travel-size spray bottle 30 for \$14 on Amazon**



**At least one water-soluble colored pencil**  
**Soft lead pencil**  
**2 or 3 oil pastel crayons.**

**Small amount of Rubbing Alcohol**  
**Palette:** Anything to mix paint on  
**Plastic bag** for garbage

**2 small water containers**  
**Newspapers** for paper lifts  
**Paper towels**

**Hand Protection:** latex gloves or barrier cream  
**Apron or a smock**  
**Journal/Notebook:** for notes, ideas, drawing, etc.
