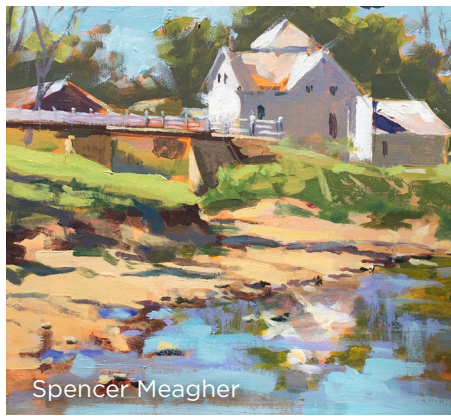


A MESSAGE FROM KYLE
