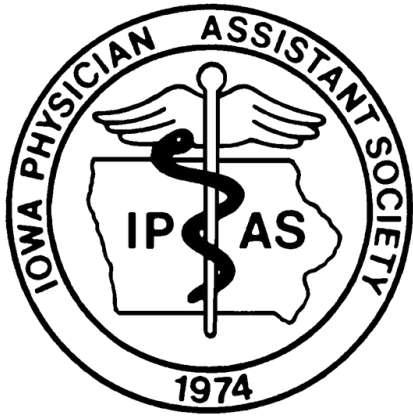

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Log Your Conference Credits Conveniently at the NCCPA Website

Go to www.nccpa.net and log on to your personal certification record.



Click “CME” on the left and then click on “Log New CME.” Once on the “Log New CME” screen, select the conference you want to log and click “Continue.”
