Freddie Gayle Reed February 29, 1936 — April 20, 2026

Freddie Gayle Reed, affectionately known as Fred, passed away on April 20, 2026, in his beloved hometown of Denton, Texas. Born on February 29, 1936, Fred was a lifelong resident of Denton, where he left an indelible mark on his community both personally and professionally.

Fred proudly graduated from Denton High School in 1954 and furthered his education at the University of North Texas. With a sharp intellect and a quick wit, he was known for his great sense of humor, traits that endeared him to friends, family, and acquaintances alike.

For over twenty years, Fred owned and operated Reed Electric, a business that served as a cornerstone in the Denton community. His dedication to his craft and his commitment to customer satisfaction were hallmarks of his professional life. Beyond his work, Fred could often be found enjoying the simple pleasures of life, including a good meal at Boomerjacks, where he was a familiar and cherished presence any day of the week. Fred was also a longtime member of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows. His membership was held at Denton Lodge No. 82 and he was an Odd Fellow for nearly 70 years.

Fred's family meant the world to him. He is survived by his son Lee Erwin; his daughter-in-law Tammy Erwin; his granddaughter Crystale Samuel and her husband Jason; his grandson Trent Erwin and his wife Makenzie; and his great-granddaughter Piper Erwin. Fred also leaves behind cherished memories with these loved ones who carry forward his legacy. He was preceded in death by his wife Ann Reed; son Richard "Ricky" Reed; daughter-in-law Deborah (Deb) Reed and granddaughter Cassie Reed.

A graveside service to honor Fred's life was held on April 25, 2026, at Roselawn Memorial Park in Denton, Texas.

Fred's life was a testament to integrity, hard work, and heartfelt connection, qualities that will continue to inspire all who knew him. His memory will forever be cherished in the hearts of those close to him and the community he loved so dearly.

**Marshall Wayne (Wayne Mush) McHenry, Jr.
September 18, 1947—July 11, 2026**

Marhsall Wayne McHenry, Jr., 78, of Greenville, passed away on Saturday, July 11, 2026, in Greenville, Texas, after a brief illness. A memorial service was held at 2:00pm on July 18, 2026, at Coker-Mathews Funeral Home Chapel with Mr. Randy Tarpley and Mr. Don Coppinger officiating.

Wayne Mush, as he was affectionately known to family and friends, was a Greenville native and retired businessman.

He was born September 18, 1947, in Greenville, Texas, to Marshall Wayne “Mush” McHenry, Sr., and Treva Glass McHenry. He graduated from Greenville High School in 1966 and served in the U.S. Navy from July 1967 to March 1971. In 2024, he was awarded the Congressional Veteran Commendation presented by Congressman Keith Self. The Commendation was received for his bravery and involvement in a 1968 military Russian interception of Seaboard World Airlines Flight 253A bound for South Vietnam. Wayne and 214 other American troops were detained in Russia for several days before being safely released. After discharge from the U.S. Navy, Wayne returned to Greenville, attended East Texas State University and joined his father in running the family business, McHenry Locksmith Shop.

Wayne and Lillian Josey were married on December 31, 1976, in Greenville and would have celebrated 50 years of marriage in December of this year.

He remained in the locksmith business for 47 years. As a second-generation locksmith, he performed commercial and residential locksmith services specializing in safes. Semi-retired as a locksmith, Wayne went to work for the U.S. Postal Service in 2007, retiring in 2023. For several years, he was a member of the Greenville Veteran of Foreign Wars and the Noon Rotary. Wayne was a lifetime member of the Greenville Disabled American Veterans Chapter 81 and a 50 plus year member of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows.

He is survived by his wife, Lillian McHenry; brother, David McHenry and wife, Terry; several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Judy McHenry Bryant.
