

I had a 100% blockage in one artery and the surgeon said it was the widowmaker. The Good Lord must not have been ready for me just

yet. I am doing fine now, but the bad news is I am going to have to wait six months to a year to be able to do anything about my back and legs. I had an appointment to get more shots in my back three days after my discharge from the hospital, but the cardiologist called them and told them I could not take the shots now and that he would let them know when I can start them again. So you will be seeing me walking around with my rolling walker for awhile. Everything else about my heart was clear.

I would like to take this time to thank the ones that called to see how I was doing and especially to Past Grand Master Troy Pennington and Billie Pennington for coming to see me while I was in the hospital.

Clarence Ray "Burley" Burleson February 15, 1945 - November 23, 2025

It is with deep sadness that the family announces the passing of Clarence Ray Burleson on November 23, 2025. Clarence was born February 15, 1945, in Mineral Wells, Texas. He graduated from Graford High School and began his career in aviation at Southern Airways, Camp Wolters, Mineral Wells, Texas, training as a helicopter mechanic. Clarence worked as a mechanic, inspector, Maintenance Director and Technical Advisor for Aeospatiale (now Airbus) for many years with a four-year hiatus in Memphis, TN, working as Maintenance Director for The Hospital Wing emergency flight service. In December, 2014, he turned his last wrench and retired at Lake Weatherford, Texas. His work took him away from Palo Pinto County but his heart always remained where he grew up on Oran, Texas.

In his younger years, Clarence was an avid deer hunter, camper and fisherman. He loved guns and weapons, tools, fast cars and helicopters. His mechanical ability was well above average and he could build and repair almost anything. If he couldn't fix something, it was probably just not meant to be fixed.

Clarence participated as a member of both the I.O.O.F. (Independent Order of Odd Fellows) and the Burleson Family Association for years, serving as a leader and officer in those organizations.

Clarence dearly loved all his family and friends and never met a stranger. He was a faithful and loving husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He is survived by his wife of 35 years, Karen (Kay) Cobb Burleson, his sons Danny Ray Burleson (wife Marie), William Wayne Burleson (wife Britney), Derek Foreman (wife Ronda) and daughters Crystal Kay Burleson and Misten Foreman; his sister, Laura Burleson Fouke; grandchildren Colton, Austin, and Dustin Burleson, William E.R. Burleson, Rachel Burleson Akins, Vivienne and Andrew Foreman, Ian and Maryn Milligan, Jasmine Sexton, Samuel Fuentes, Tyler Gay and nine great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, Benjamin OT and Willie Alverine Burleson of Oran, Texas.
