# *Pastor's Corner*

What a winter it has been! Perhaps the best encapsulation of this year's winter months, comes from the hymn, "In the Bleak Midwinter." Especially the line in verse one which states, "snow on snow, snow on snow." Is anyone else ready to turn the page to spring? Who is ready for sunshine, warmer temperatures, and the first signs of life emerging from beneath the frozen tundra we call Pennsylvania?

Well friends, hang in there, spring is on the way. Which also means that Easter is right around the corner: April 5<sup>th</sup> to be exact. On the way to Easter, we will journey together through the annual season called "Lent." Lent is a time for all of us to look forward to the joys of Easter, while at the same time taking a moment to pause, reflect, and take stock of our lives. During the season of lent, we reflect upon our need for a Savior. We reflect upon our desperate need for Jesus.
