Be Bold With Your Good News!

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus says: "What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light." He's calling you and commissioning you and empowering you, through his



Holy Spirit, to share your good news with others, so that they can hear him in *their* darkness. Proclaim it boldly and visibly so that those who want to hear it will stop and listen. Do not be afraid to openly share how Jesus has been working in your life and how he's helped you grow or heal or turn away from sin. Yes, when we're this bold, some people ridicule us and reject us, like how Jeremiah was treated in the first reading. But the Lord is with you, too, as "a mighty champion," and your persecutors will eventually stumble and fail. Jesus tells us to "fear no one." God takes good care of us.

Jesus acknowledges those who acknowledge him. In other words, when we're insulted or persecuted for our faith, God holds us and comforts us. It's *his* opinion of us that matters anyway, and no one else's. Listen to him. In the whispers of the sanctuary of your heart, he's telling you all the good that he sees in you. Explore the Gospel as a family: Matthew 10: 26-33 – 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time – Courage in Faith; Trust in God –

The readings this weekend teaches us to trust in God's care, even when we are afraid (to have courage). It reminds us that he is with us, giving us strength and guiding us in faith.. Family Chat: What words or phrases in today's Gospel reading catch your ear? What image from this reading touches your heart? Jesus tells us that he will remember us to his Father if we proclaim him to others. How easy is it for you to talk about your faith with your friends? How about your family or people you don't know very well?

Family Challenge: Today's readings remind us speak and live the truth even when it is difficult. Trust God instead of letting fear control your choices. This week encourage someone who is struggling or afraid. Pray each day for courage and trust in God.

Family Activity: Say a family prayer with petitions for people who live in frightening surroundings. Include your own intentions. Respond, "Lord, in your great love, hear our prayer."

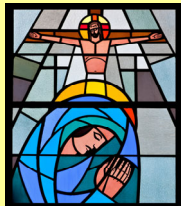
Liturgy Link: What color did the priest wear at Mass today? When was the last time you saw the priest wear this same color? What does the color change signify?

Family Prayer: Prayer Against Fear *Invite each family member to think of something that may be causing them anxiety or fear and to bring it before Jesus in this prayer.*

Lord Jesus, draw near to me now and hear my prayer. Lord, you know my heart and my innermost thoughts. You see the struggle within me and the battle between mind and heart. I ask you, O Lord, please release me from this fear. Let me bask in your Holiness and remain calm, knowing that you are Lord and Savior. You died for my sins, and you will never abandon me. Send your Spirit upon me to comfort me and give me peace. I thank you for your everlasting love. Amen.

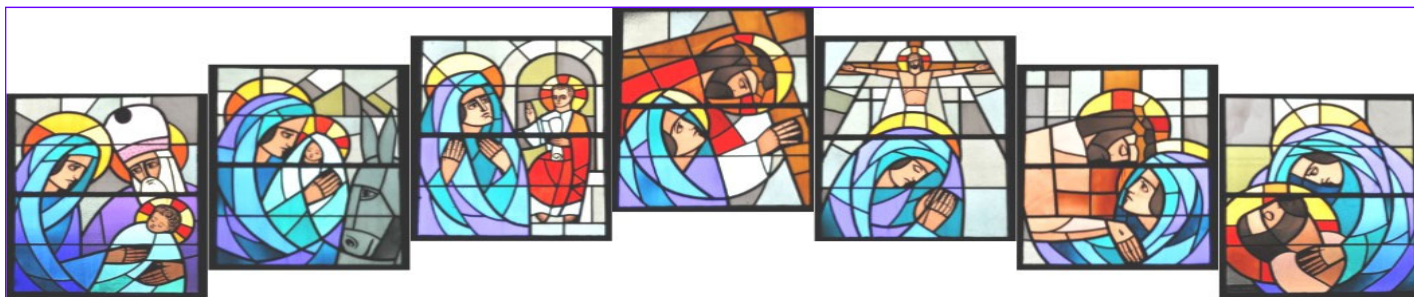
