We welcome your child to be baptized at Mater Dolorosa Church. Baptisms take place the fourth Saturday of every month at 11:30 a.m. Baptism Preparation Class is offered for families of scheduled baptisms, the third Saturday of every month at 11:30 a.m. Parents should contact the Parish Center *three months prior* to the desired date of the baptism to allow for preparation and for scheduling.

Families must be enrolled in Family Faith Formation one year prior to the direct preparation for each Sacrament.

Families must be enrolled in Family Faith Formation one year prior to the direct preparation for the reception of Confirmation.

Season the World With Your Faith

This Sunday, Jesus tells us: "You are the salt of the earth." Jesus raises the point that if we lose our flavor, how can it be restored? The answer is: Only by letting God renew us.

People are much more likely to turn to Jesus if

they first experience his love from us, and his peace in how we treat them, and his joy in the way we live our lives. They need to discover that Jesus loves them just the way they are, that he is gentle but sincere when inviting them to grow spiritually, and that he can help them turn hardships and troubles into blessings and joys.

Jesus also tells us to be a light that others cannot help but notice — but not a light that blinds. To flavor the lives of others with the presence of Jesus, we have to let his light shine in us. We have to be so lit up by Christ that others cannot help but notice. Additionally, Jesus says that we have to be a city. We cannot evangelize alone. A "city" is a group of Christians: a parish, a family, a church organization. Being Christian means being in community. When our light is joined to the light of others, our collective glow is much more effective in revealing Christ to the world. Why? Because non-believers learn that the love of Christ is real when they see us living in love with each other: unconditionally, generously, with a servant's heart (see Acts 2:42-47).



Meet Our Extended Family: St. Josephine Bakhita

(February 8) - St. Josephine Bakhita is an African saint, who was born in Sudan around 1869. She was kidnapped as a child and taken as a slave by Arab traders and suffered a difficult life until her eventual freedom in Italy. Josephine's freedom came when she needed a temporary place to stay while her masters moved abroad without her. Her owners left her in the custody of the Canossian Sisters in Venice. There, she was baptized, confirmed, and received Holy Communion. Josephine eventually became a nun with the Canossian Daughters of Charity and lived and worked with them for 45 years.
