How

What to do?

3. Group Work phase 1

- b. Be ready to present the individuals names in plenum
- 4. **Plenum**: The groups share observed signs of barriers

5. Group Work phase 2

- a. Each group choose one person/profile from the wall
- b. Analyse the behaviour in relation to barriers to learning, conclude, and make suggestions on how Peter Toft should react in order to address the barriers to learning and to release the potential learning energy in the participant
- c. Prepare presentation as roleplay.

6. Group Work phase 3

- a. Role Play each group present their suggestion as role play
- b. Play the roles in the situation until the point, when the barrier is noticed, and then change the progress to reflect *your* solution
- c. We will all learn and get inspiration from your presentation
