## 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

As we observe the people around us, we notice that there are many different types of personalities. Some are highly active, while others are quite the opposite. Yet, in between, there are always a few who remain in a neutral position.

Those who have discovered the meaning and purpose of life cannot simply stop their journey.
