The Church is alive when her young people are alive. Pope Benedict XVI reminded us that "the Church needs your enthusiasm, your creativity, and the joy that is so characteristic of you." He saw youth not only as the future, but as a vital presence in the mission of the Church today. Rooted in Christ, young people can bring new energy, courage, and hope to our parish family.



Pope Leo XIV has continued this vision. Together—youth, parents, and the entire parish community—we can ensure that our parish remains a place of joy, hope, and renewal.
