CORPUS CHRISTI (Year C)

In the Old Testament, God made a promise to His people: "For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land... a land flowing with milk and honey." (Deuteronomy 8:7–8). This land of promise is more than just geography—it is a place of divine abundance and presence. In the fullness of time, this promise finds its deeper meaning in Bethlehem, the very town where Jesus was born. Interestingly, Bethlehem means "House of Bread"—a prophetic sign of the gift God was preparing for His people.



Today, as we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we recognize that the true "milk and honey," the true nourishment of the Promised Land, is Jesus Himself, fully present in the Eucharist. Through the Holy Spirit, God still leads His people—not just to a physical place—but to a sacred reality: the living Bread come down from heaven.

In the Eucharist, Jesus offers His very Body as food for our souls. This is the Bread prepared by the Son, given to us by the Father, and made present by the power of the Holy Spirit.

As we take part in the procession and Benediction blessing at the end of the mass, we realise: we are the new chosen people being led by the Spirit into the Promised Land—into communion with Christ in the Eucharist. It is not just bread we receive—it is the living presence of our Lord.

May this feast renew in us the wonder of the Eucharist and strengthen our unity as the Body of Christ.
