Quick Reference for Veterans Benefits

Did the Veteran die or will the Veteran die at a VA Hospital?

- 1.Gets \$978 burial or cremation allowance. (If veteran died on or after 10/1/24)
- 2.Gets \$978 plot allowance if they don't use a National Cemetery & they have a receipt.
- 3. Gets transportation from VA hospital
- 4. Gets transportation to place of burial
- 5. Use of National Cemetery is permitted for Veteran & spouse

Did the Veteran die outside a VA Hospital?

Did the Veteran receive a monthly VA service-connected disability pension?

- 1.Gets \$978 burial or cremation allowance. (If veteran died on or after 10/1/24)
- 2.Gets \$978 plot allowance if they don't use a National Cemetery & they have a receipt.
- 3. If they are service connected, transportation will be paid only if buried in a National Cemetery.
- 4. Use of National Cemetery is permitted for Veteran & eligible spouse

Did the Veteran receive a 100% service-connected disability pension?

- 1. Must have died from service connection! If so, up to \$2,000 is reimbursed to family on funeral/cremation costs.
- 2. Use of National Cemetery is permitted for Veteran & eiligible spouse

Burial in National Cemetery

All honorably discharged veterans are entitled to free grave space for the Veteran, eligible spouse, minor children up to 21-years-old and adult dependent children. Conditions to be met:

- Honorably discharged or under honorable conditions veteran serving any length of time before 9/7/80.
- Veterans entering service after this time must serve 24 months of continuous active duty or for the full time for which the person was called to active duty.
