Eustis Gun Club Steel Target Rules for Cowboy Action events, matches, and practice

These rules apply to Swampwater, Eustis Gun Club Pistol Berms 1-6, and any other set stages on ranges 7 or 8

- ALL Shotgun Targets will be at minimum of 8 yards or 24 feet, NO CLOSER
- No Targets will be higher than 5 feet 5 inches measured from the dirt
- Pistol Targets at 7 yards and 20 Degrees measured from the face of the target
 - No targets closer than 5 yards or 15 feet
 - Targets moved closer than 7 yards must have angle of target increased
 2.5 degrees per every yard moved closer
- Rifle Targets will be no closer than 10 yards
 - 20 degree angle for stationary targets
 - Poppers must have a cover over the top
 - Poppers must be staggered at least 6" apart in depth from the firing line
 - No poppers closer than 10 yards
- Swampwater firing line will be at the windows or doorways/ boardwalk not in front of windows or doors or inside Swampwater
 - With the exception of "SALOON" inside swinging doors; PISTOLS ONLY will be shot, targets at 5-7 yards
- LCPistoleros work in progress- NO MILD STEEL AUTHORIZED, complete replacement of all steel to AR500 flat steel at least 3/8" as soon as possible. Including all pitted, convex, and concave targets replace to flat AR500 steel (½" is HIGHLY recommended)
- Top guard extension on the long target rack and cover all angle iron bases and flat steel uprights to minimize ricochet
- If any targets are moved to a different course of fire, shooting will cease immediately until RSO can measure and approve the new target placement.
- All Friday Match Setup will be inspected and measured by the RSO on duty. All

stages must be approved by the RSO before the Saturday match will commence. NO changes can be made to stages once RSO approves the targets for that match.

• Any and all injuries large or small need to be reported to the RSO on duty, and an incident report completed (whether it be from a staple gun or splatter from a bullet fragment)
