After Your Pavers Are Sealed

Simple care instructions to protect your newly sealed pavers and keep them looking their best.

Your pavers are sealed — now give them time to cure. The first 24-48 hours are the most important. Following these simple guidelines helps protect the finish and allows the sealer to properly cure.

THE FIRST 24-48 HOURS

- ✓ **Keep vehicles off the surface** - Do not drive or park on newly sealed pavers for 24-48 hours, or until the timeframe provided by your technician.
- ✓ **Limit foot traffic** - Avoid unnecessary walking on the surface during the initial cure period. Follow the instructions we provide at completion.
- ✓ **Keep irrigation off** - Do not allow sprinklers to run over the sealed area during the initial cure period.
- ✓ **Keep heavy items off** - Wait before replacing grills, large planters, heavy furniture or other items that could leave marks while the sealer is curing.

ROUTINE CARE

- ✓ **Clean spills promptly** - Oil, fertilizer, rust, food, leaves and other materials can stain pavers. Address spills and debris as soon as practical.
- ✓ **Use gentle cleaning methods** - For routine cleaning, use water and a mild paver-safe cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals unless they are specifically approved for sealed pavers.
- ✓ **Be careful with pressure washing** - Excessive pressure or aggressive surface cleaning can damage joint sand or the sealed finish. Professional maintenance is recommended.
- ✓ **Watch your irrigation** - Sprinkler overspray can cause mineral deposits, rust staining and premature wear. Keep irrigation heads properly adjusted.

HELP YOUR PAVERS LOOK GREAT LONGER

- ✓ **Keep joints and drainage clear** - Remove accumulated leaves, dirt and debris so water can drain properly.
- ✓ **Address weeds early** - Occasional weeds can develop from wind-blown seeds and organic material. Treat them before they become established.
- ✓ **Avoid dragging heavy objects** - Lift furniture, grills and planters instead of dragging them across the sealed surface.
- ✓ **Plan for maintenance** - Sealed pavers are easier to maintain, but they are not maintenance-free. Periodic professional cleaning and resealing help preserve their appearance and protection.

GOOD TO KNOW

Weather, shade, humidity and the condition of the pavers can affect cure time. Always follow the specific instructions your Supreme Paver Experts technician gives you when the job is completed.
