More than 34 mission-oriented agencies participate in the GRCoC. These homeless service agencies develop and deliver trauma-informed programming, share data with GRCoC partners, provide extensive reports to federal and state funders, undergo audits and monitoring visits to ensure compliance, and commit to continuous quality improvement in order to meet the needs of our neighbors.
