The Greater Richmond Continuum of Care (GRCoC) is a coordinated and compassionate network of homeless service providers in our region supporting our neighbors pushed into homelessness. More than 34 mission-oriented agencies participate in the GRCoC. These homeless service agencies develop and deliver trauma-informed programming, share data with GRCoC partners, provide extensive reports to federal and state funders, undergo audits and monitoring visits to ensure compliance, and commit to continuous quality improvement in order to meet the needs of our neighbors.

GRCoC Board: Elected by GRCoC membership to serve as the governing body and help accomplish GRCoC's mission to prevent, reduce, and end homelessness through effective and coordinated. The Board has the power to act on behalf of and in the best interest of GRCoC.
