The board voted to approve the proposed slates for the Ranking committee and the Governance Committee.

The board voted to approve Tabitha Taylor as a replacement board member for Mychael Lee.

Staff provided updates on the board-endorsed Pandemic Program Wind Down and Seasonal Shelter task forces. The composition and dates were set for both groups. Recommendations to be shared with board for endorsement upon completion.

Board members reviewed Bottletree Consulting's Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program assessment and recommendations. The final recommendation was to not apply for funding. Instead, work on identifying partners, building infrastructure, and then apply for the grant next year. Staff recommended to develop partnerships through the application process.

The board received an update on rapid re-housing during the temporary suspension of family prioritization.

The System Policy and Process (SPP) Committee chair called for a vote on extending the membership to a 2-year term, adding a non-voting Coordinated Entry representative to SPP, a pandemic prevention access amendment, and the temporary (until 8/1) suspension of RRH prioritization for single adults. All items were approved.

The board approved renewing the annual MoUs with Homeward as the designated Collaborative Applicant and Coordinated Entry System Coordinator for the GRCoC.
