Deaths Occurring Outside Macon County

Effective January 1, 2024 - Due to recent concerns with the safety of vital records and delivery delays with the US Postal Service - for any death that occurs outside of Macon County, Brintlinger and Earl Funeral Home will call and order death certificates on your behalf and can add these charges to your contract. However, if death certificates are being mailed, we will ask the county registrar to add tracking so that we can track death certificates in the mail to ensure that vital records reach our office safely. This will add an additional charge of approximately \$5.00 to the cost of the death certificates. If you would like us to mail death certificates to you, we will use USPS Priority Mail with Tracking which will add an additional \$20.00 fee.

The containers we offer are alternative containers made of fiberboard or composite wood.


