

Conditions of Entry

1. The entrant undertakes that:
 - a. The outfit/s submitted is the entrant's own work.
 - b. The entrant will be between the ages of 13 – 18 years old at the time of the Spring Parade 2026 for Category 2 & 3 - Student Entry; and over 18 for Category 1 - Open Entry.
 - c. For Category 2 & 3 the entrant is undertaking secondary studies defined as year 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 regardless of which institute these studies are being undertaken at.
2. The entrant will take all responsibility for delivery, and collection of fashion mood board/garment/outfit/s at Fairholme College.
3. A parent or guardian must acknowledge permission on the entry form if under 18.
4. An entry is defined by: one outfit/ensemble per entry accompanied by an entry form, and other pre requisites as per point 7 a - f, and media consent form.
5. There shall be one designer per entry.
6. Designers are allowed/encouraged to enter multiple entries.
7. **Prerequisites Categories 1,2 & 3** –Any entries received that do not meet the criteria specified in each respective category will be ineligible.
 - a) The outfit must be hand made from start to finish by the entrant.
 - b) Made to fit a Fairholme model (student) between sizes 8 to 16.
 - c) The outfit must reflect original ideas inspired by the “theme context” and noted through an A4 mood board which includes sketches of proposed design/s
 - d) May use a commercial pattern that is adapted to suit the brief
 - e) Photos (at least 3) of the construction process as evidence
8. Each entrant will be required to be present for 1.5 hours before the event for a pre-judging interview with the judges to enable the judges to reach a decision.
9. Fairholme College will not be liable to any entrant for loss or damage to any entry whether or not such loss was caused by or occurred as a result of a negligent act and/or omission on the part of Fairholme College, its students or teachers.
10. All entrants shall make their entries (outfit/s) available for media purposes as required by Fairholme and the Event sponsors. By entering entrants are taken to agree to their work being photographed and used by Fairholme on various media and platforms for this and future event promotion.
11. The decision of the judges shall be final, and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Judging

The Judging panel shall consist of a minimum of three judges selected from Industry professionals.

Technical Judging

The technical judging is to determine the excellence of the design, originality, choice of fabric, use of material and cut, together with the overall sewing skills applied.

An example of the criteria used in Categories 1, 2 and 3 judging is listed below:
