



Parent/Guardian,

Your child qualifies for intervention through our Title I Program. The Title I program supplements and supports the instruction your child receives in their regular classroom. It features individualized instruction tailored to your child's specific reading and/or math needs. This targeted, individualized instruction is to help your child reach grade-level proficiency.

Acadience math and reading assessments are administered three times per year for all students, followed by progress monitoring to track student progress and growth. RISE is an end-of-the-year assessment to show student proficiency in grades three through six. State assessments have shown that your child still needs to meet one or more grade-level benchmarks or proficiency. This data indicates that your child would benefit from supplemental interventions through our Title I Program.

Our goal at Book Cliff Elementary is to help every student achieve academic success in reading, language arts, and math. To help those students who qualify for the Title I program, we provide these supplemental services:

1. ***Small-Group Instruction*** – *Our interventionists and paraprofessionals are assigned to classrooms to work individually or in small groups with students who are identified as needing Title I support. Under a teacher's supervision, instruction is designed to remediate the student's deficiencies and provide additional practice in reading or math.*
2. ***One-to-One Tutoring*** – *Our interventionists and paraprofessionals are assigned to classrooms to work individually with students who are identified as needing Title I support. Working with the classroom teacher, the interventionist, and the paraprofessional provides the student with individualized instruction and practice in reading or math skills.*

Please discuss the assessment results with your child's teacher and the supplemental services your child will be provided. We will continue these services until your child performs at or above grade level. For your child to succeed, we must all be committed to helping him/her at school and at home. By working together, we can help your child achieve academic success.
