JOIN US FOR OUR JUNE 1ST GRASSROOTS LAUNCH!

On Monday, June 1st at 12:30 p.m. our Population Health team and volunteers will meet on the first floor of the Golisano Center for Community Health, 533 10th Street, Niagara Falls, to officially launch the start of the 2026 Grassroots campaign.

We invite you to join us as we begin this year's effort to connect the underserved residents of Niagara Falls to the health care, they need to live healthy and productive lives.

The targeted neighborhoods for June 1st outreach include Depot Avenue, Grove Avenue, and Fairfield Avenue.

Our team will be knocking on doors to connect residents to primary care. On the spot appointments will be made and people lacking transportation will be connected to our van driver program.

The Niagara Falls Memorial Mobile Health Van will accompany our crew as they canvas city neighborhoods. Residents will be encouraged to access the no-cost services provided on the van, including blood pressure screening, glucose testing, wound care, sick visits, health education, and other basic health care services.

This year, our outreach program will incorporate a behavioral health social worker to help residents access essential mental health services.

WHAT ARE THE SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH?

Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) are the non-medical conditions in which people are born, grow, live, work, and age. SDOH factors like housing, food, literacy, and health insurance coverage shape everyday life and have a profound impact on a person's health, well-being, and quality of life.



As part of our grassroots outreach, our team screens residents to detect SDOH needs. Community members with identified SDOH issues are connected to the right service organizations and agencies that can help address needs. Our team has built a mini-service network consisting of 24 local organizations that respond to our referrals and close service loops.

Last year when we screened community members for SDOH needs, we found that food scarcity and housing instability were among the top issues identified.

SDOH screening will remain an essential part of our 2026 outreach efforts.
