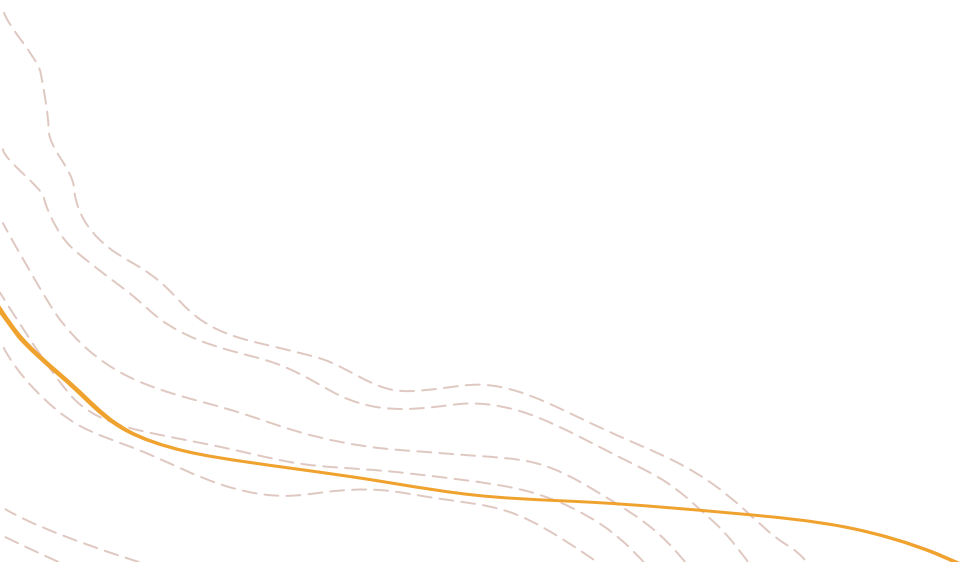




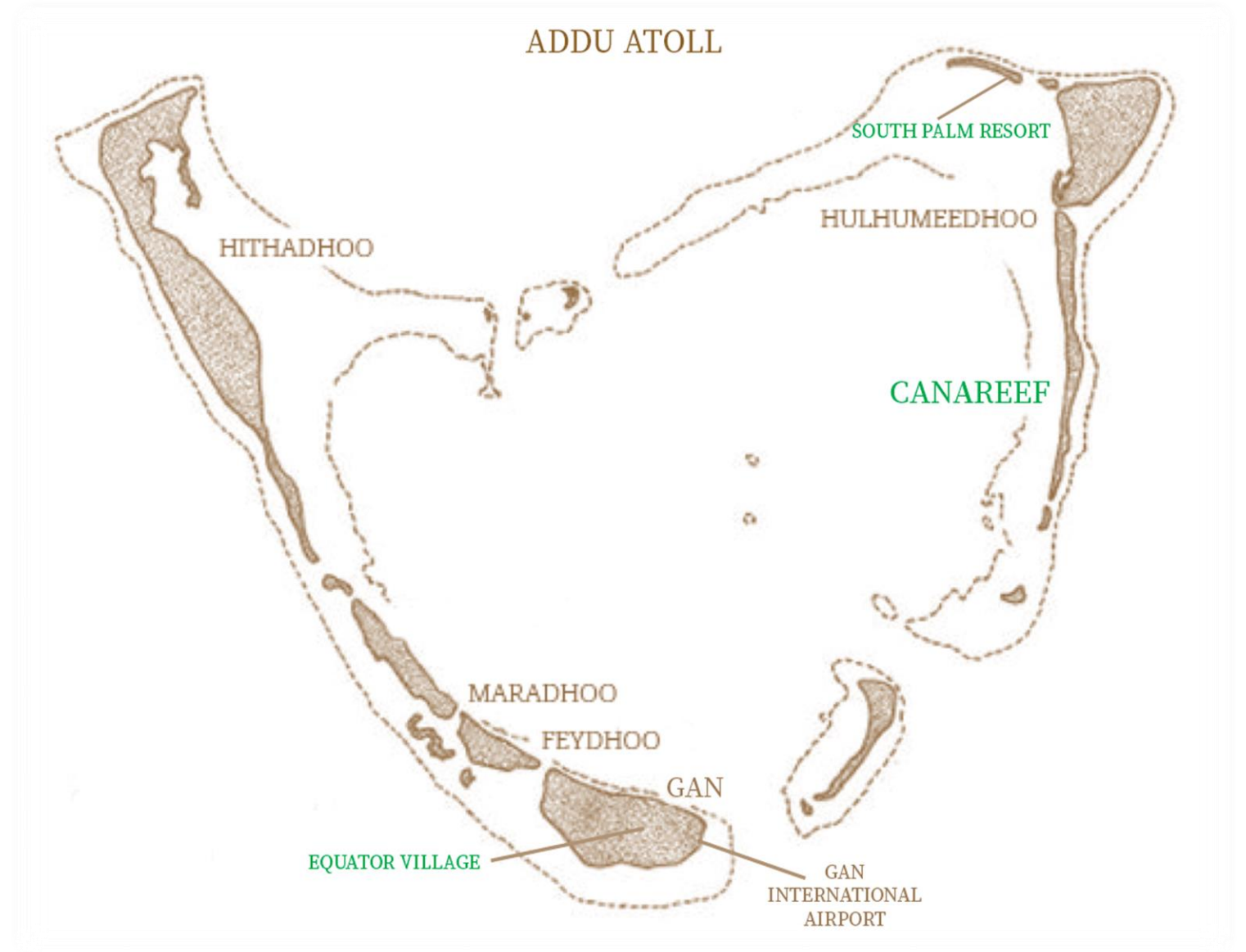

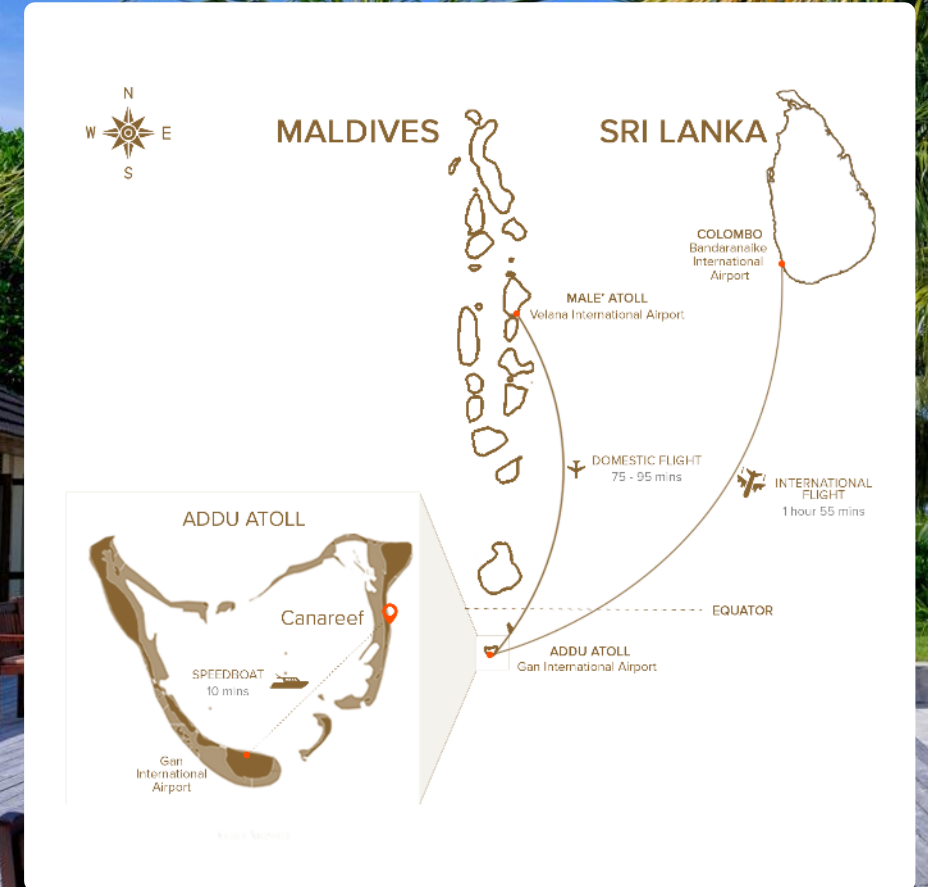
TRANSFERS

There are two ways to reach Canareef.

Option 1 involves flying to Male' International Airport, taking a 75-95 minute domestic flight to Gan Airport, and then a 10-minute speedboat ride to Canareef.

Option 2 is flying directly to Gan International Airport via Colombo, followed by a short 10-minute speedboat ride to Canareef.

Our representatives will be at both airports to welcome you and assist you with your transfers. Complimentary lounge services will be provided for all guests arriving to the resort.



ARRIVAL TO MALDIVES

- Guests will be met by Airport Representative at Male' Airport holding resort placard.
- Representative will assist with check-in at Domestic Terminal.
- Guests can relax at Moonimaa Lounge with free Wi-Fi and refreshments.
- Upon arrival at Gan airport, our Representative will direct guests to the Speed Boat.
- On departure for those with over 4 hours transit between domestic and international flights, complimentary lounge services will be available at Male' airport.



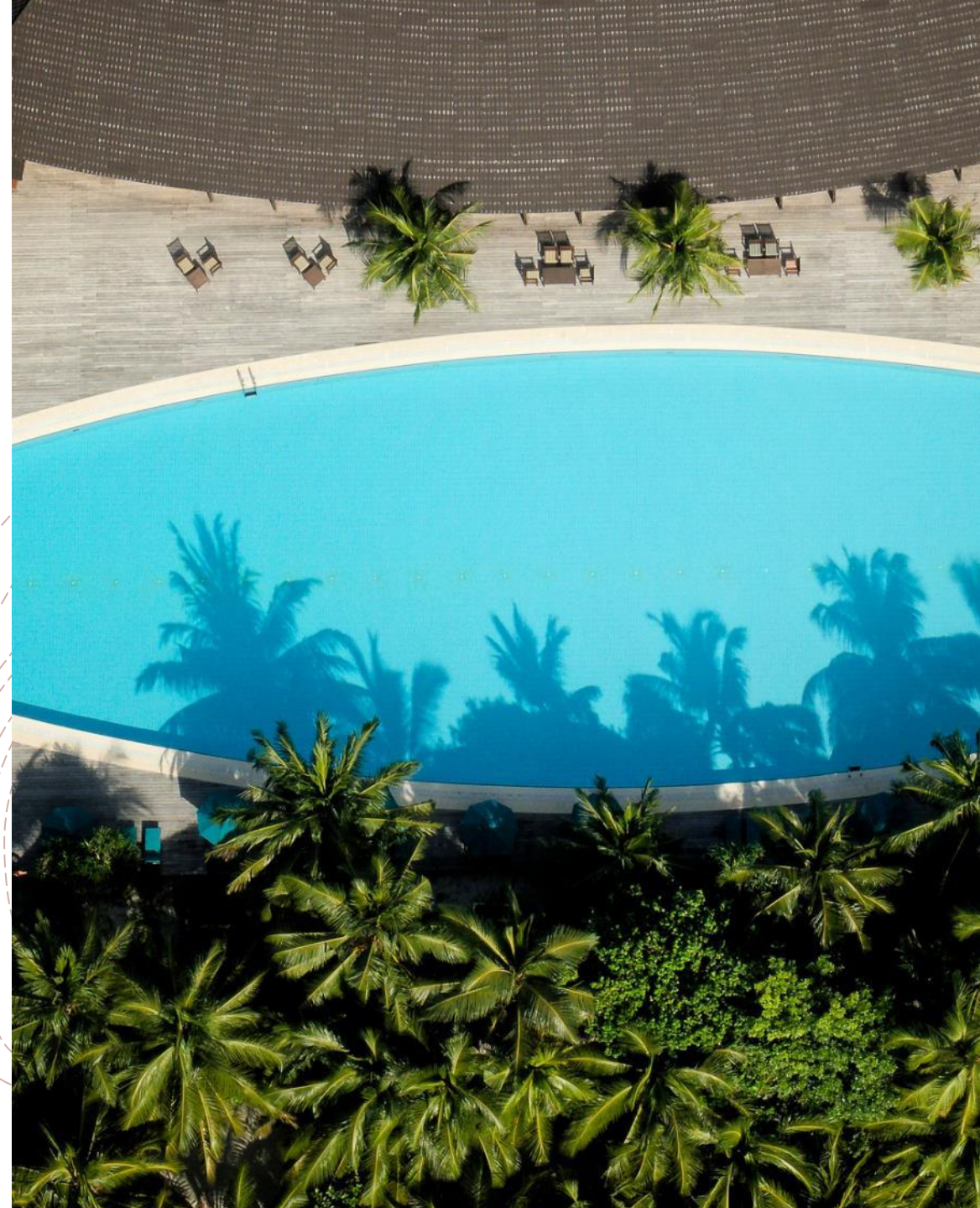
OVERVIEW

Discover the ecological wonders of our resort with large freshwater lakes and wetlands, teeming with diverse wildlife and marine life.

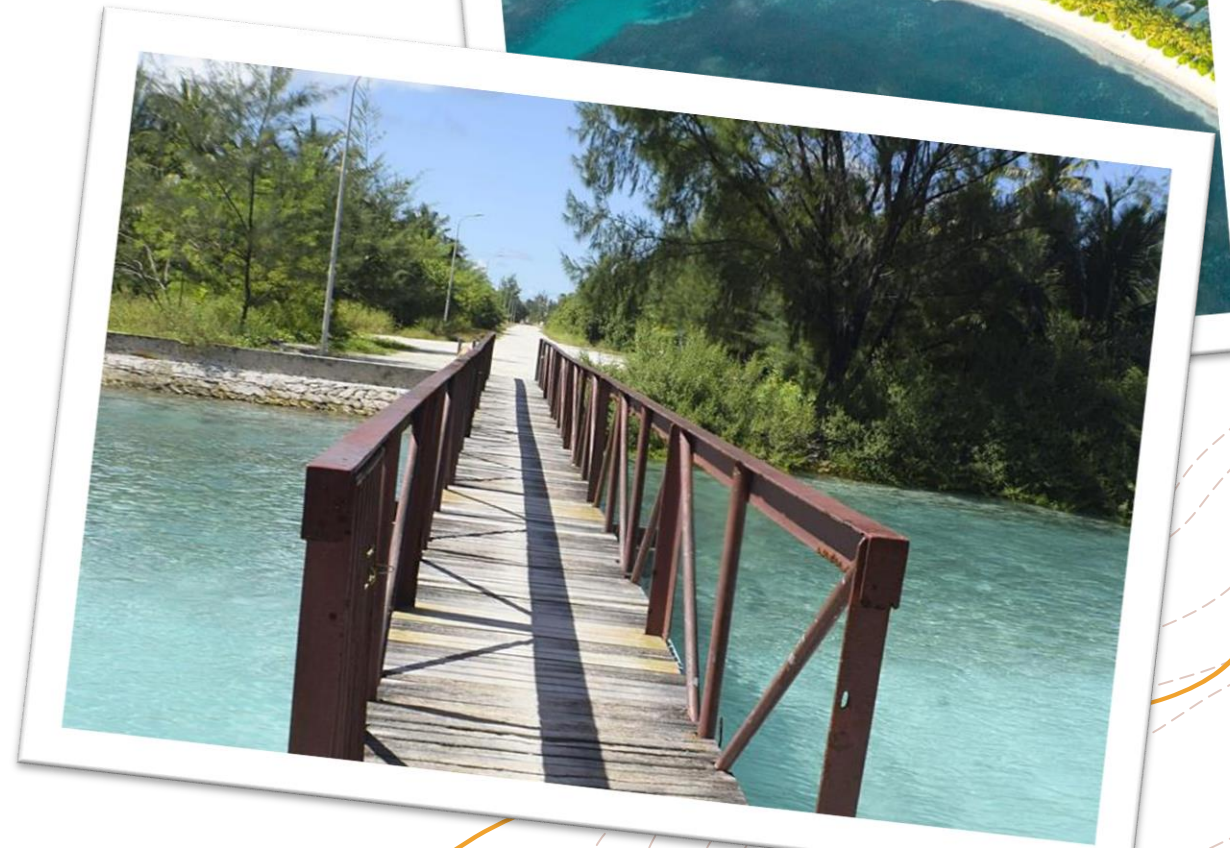

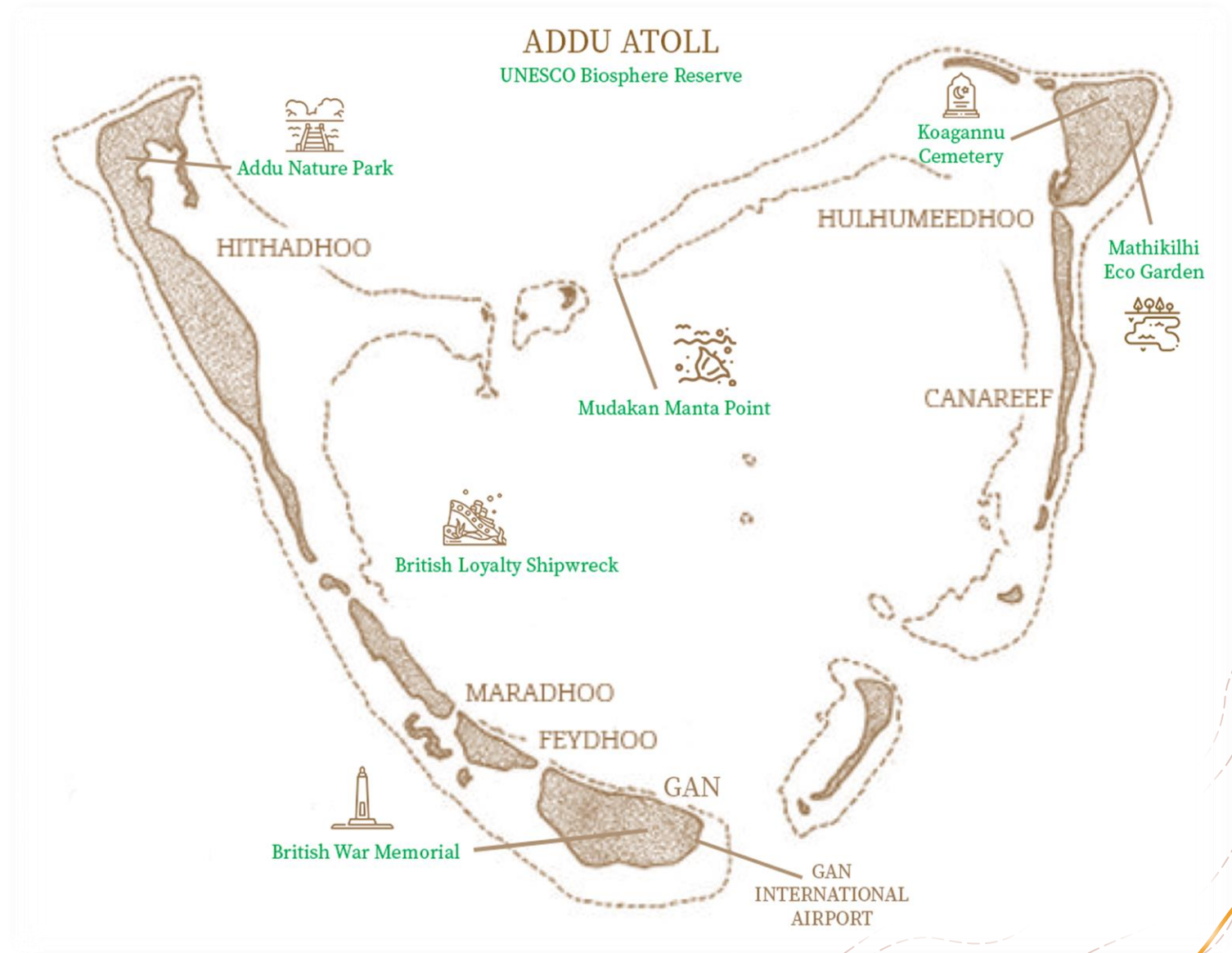


USPS OF CANAREEF

- Canareef is one of the largest resorts in the Maldives with a coastal length of 4.5km
- It is the only resort in the Maldives connected to an inhabited island via a bridge
- The resort features large wetlands, most notably 5 salt & fresh water lakes & mangroves.
- Various birds, marine life found within the island
- One of the southern most islands in the Maldives
- The first beach resort developed in Addu Atoll

USPS OF ADDU ATOLL

- Addu Atoll is a **UNESCO Biosphere Reserve**
- Addu is home to diverse marine life, unique coral formations, and mangrove areas including **2 nature parks**.
- During the Second World War and the subsequent Cold War period, the British established a **Royal Air Force (RAF) base** on Gan Island in Addu and a **World War II memorial** remains on Gan today.
- Addu has preserved many Maldivian traditions, from boat-building techniques to local crafts, folklore and delicacies such as **Addu Bondi**.
- **The largest shipwreck in the Maldives “British Loyalty”** resides in the waters of Addu Atoll.
- The oldest Muslim cemetery in the Maldives, **“Koagannu” cemetery** exists in Addu Atoll
- Addu atoll has **27 dive spots** around the atoll
- **Year round sighting of manta rays** and large fish including **tiger sharks**, silver tips and green turtles

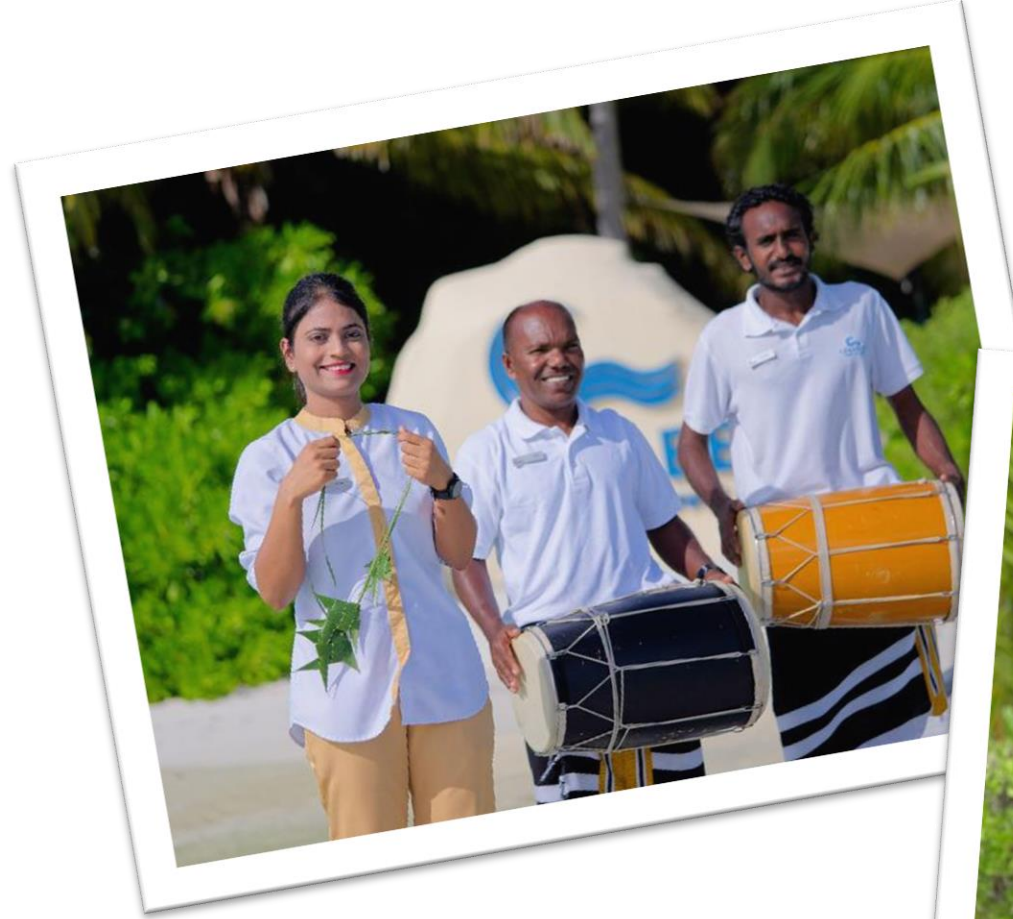

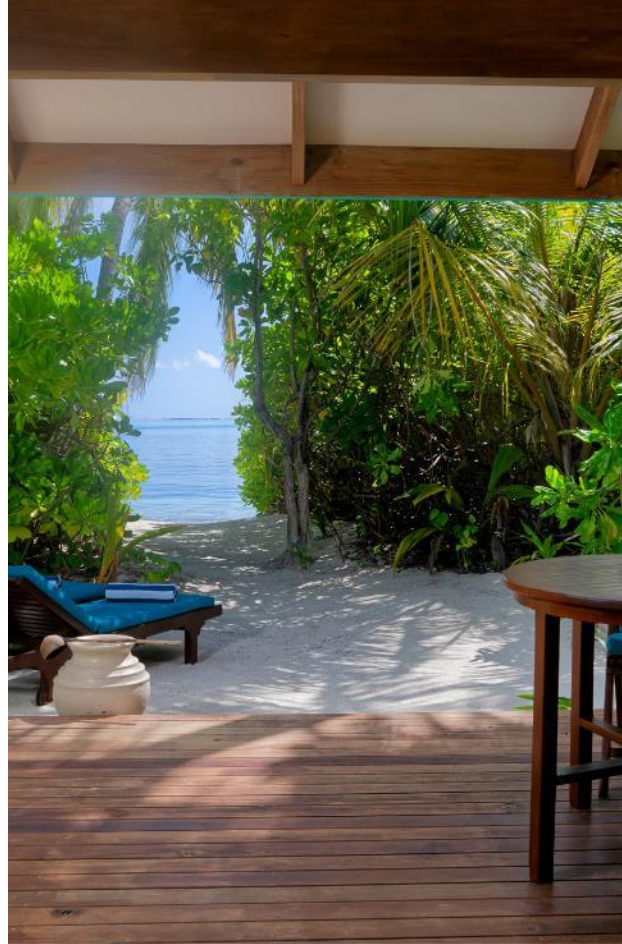

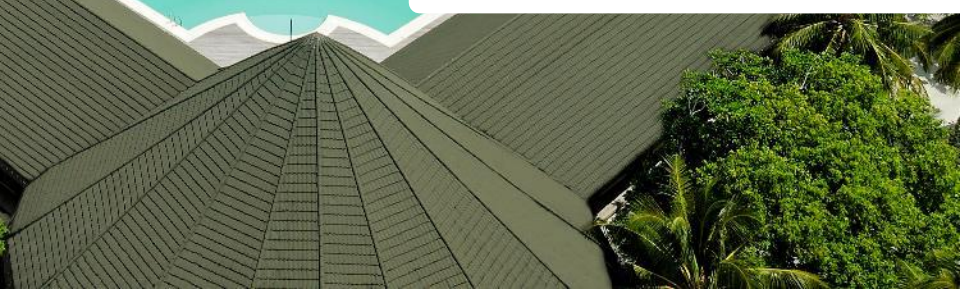


DHONI BAR

A bar located on the southernmost end of the resort with a view of the lagoon

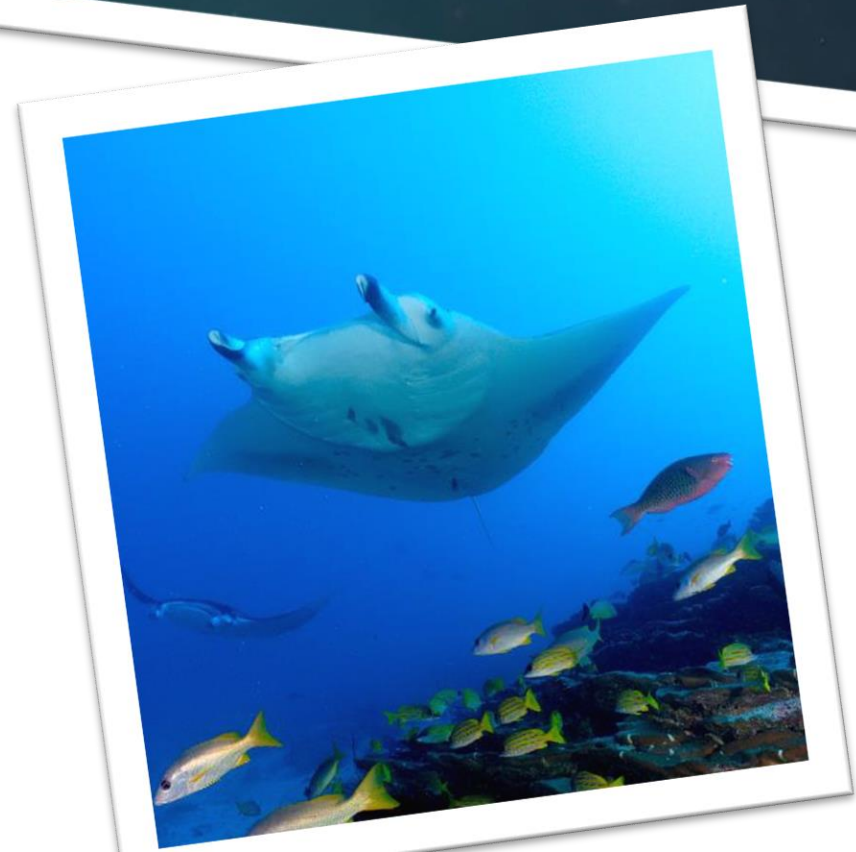
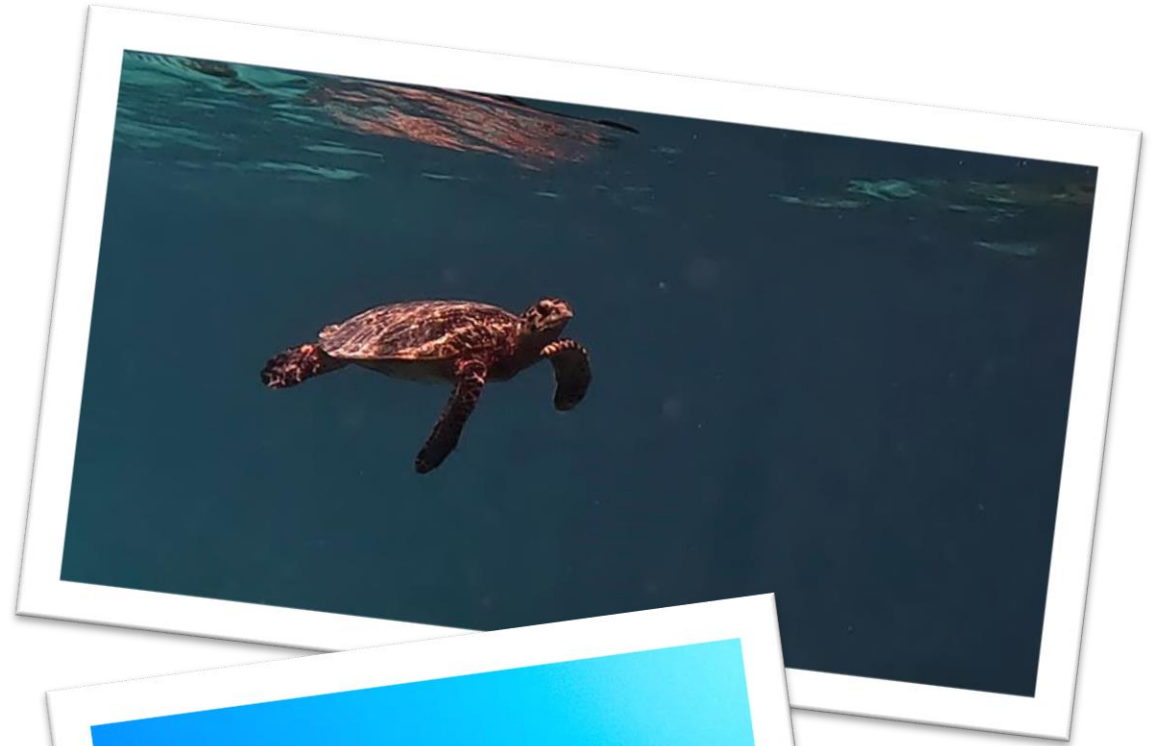




BEACH BAR

There are 10 individual treatment rooms.

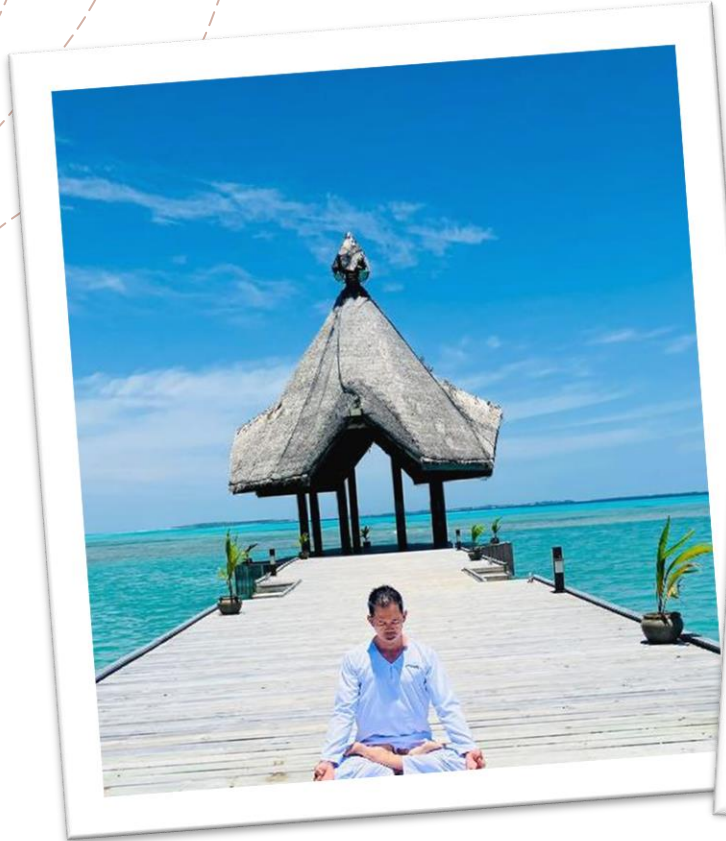

Spa products are sourced from Bali, Indonesia.



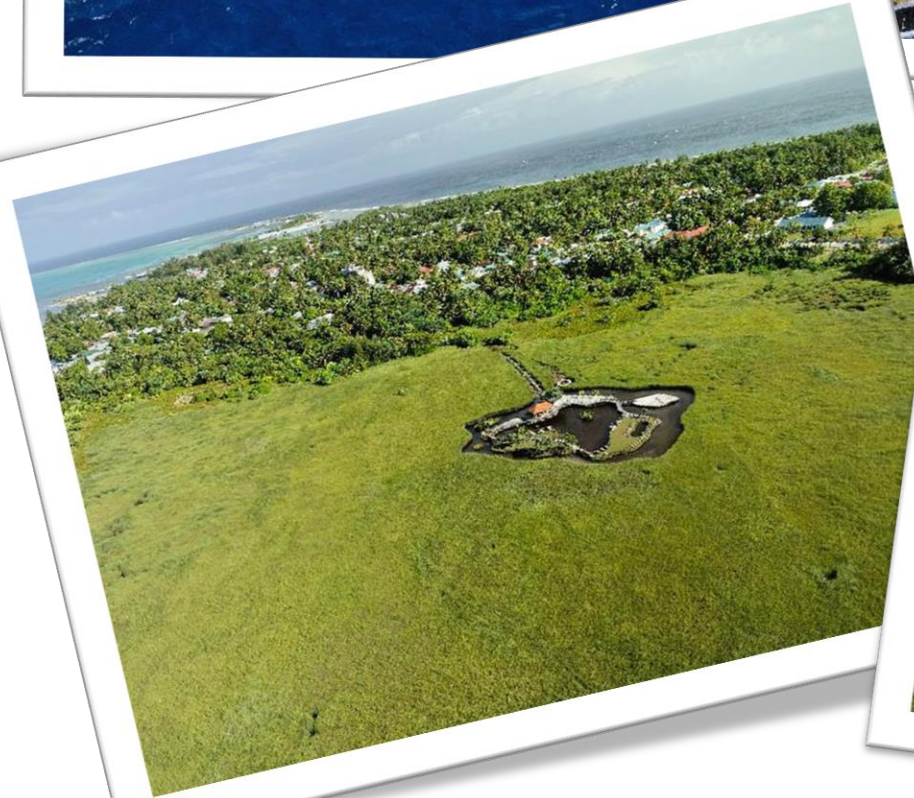

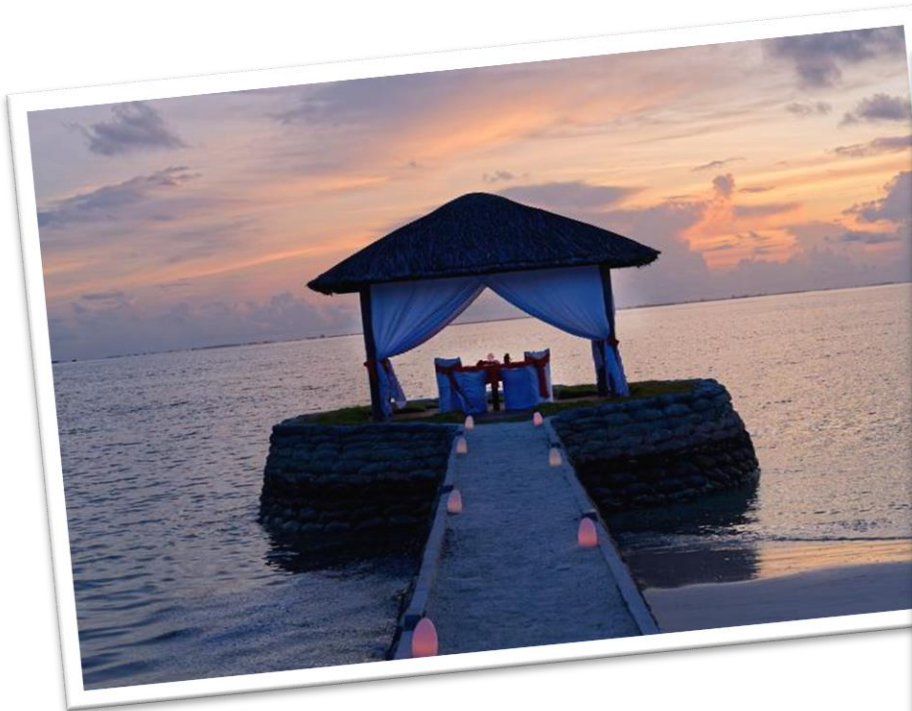
