## Reethi Thila

Also known as Five Rocks, this site is nestled between Dhangethi and Dhigurah. Marvel at the colourful sea fans and whip corals, swim alongside jackfish and barracudas, and spot the elusive white-tip and grey reef sharks.

## Broken Rock

Located in the channel between Dhangethi and Dhigurah. Be amazed by the majestic fan corals, encounter Napoleon wrasse, white-tip and grey reef sharks, and swim with turtles. Watch out for camouflaged scorpion fish and moray eels amidst a backdrop of soft coral, nudibranchs, and flatworms.

## Kuda Rah Thila

This tiny reef is home to thousands of blue-striped snappers, giant trevallies and big blue-fin trevallies too. White-tip and grey reef sharks are very often seen. And if you are lucky, you may even see a spotted eagle ray hanging around!

## Noo Giri

An underwater spectacle with schools of bannerfish and butterflyfish amidst anemones and black coral trees. Encounter glassfish, cleaner shrimps, moray eels, and vibrant nudibranchs. Marvel at scorpion fish, longnose hawkfish, and lionfish, swim with hawksbill turtles and fusiliers, and experience the thrill of white-tip and grey reef sharks.

## Thinfushi Ethere Thila

Dive into the channel between Dhangethi and Dhigurah to explore stunning sea fans and whip corals. Encounter marbled groupers, turtles, and oriental sweetlips, and swim with schools of blue-striped snappers. Watch for Napoleon wrasse and blue-fin trevallies, and thrill at the sight of white-tip, grey reef, and nurse sharks.

## Kudhi Maa Wreck

Located on Centara Grand house reef, inner atoll. Encounter nudibranchs, white-tip reef sharks, nurse sharks, and a school of big-eye jacks. Spot unique marine life like pipefish, Acropora crab, lionfish, red snappers, juvenile yellow boxfish, angelfish, pufferfish, glassfish, reef groupers, stonefish, anthias, and the marbled stingray.

## Madivaru Rangali Manta Point

Experience the Rangali south channel, a haven for reef manta rays, white-tip, grey reef, and silvertip sharks. Encounter turtles, Napoleon wrasse, and possibly even the awe-inspiring whale shark! Admire the gorgeous hard coral formations in this underwater paradise.

## Maamigili Corner

A spectacular reef of hard corals, where whale sharks, grey reef sharks, and white-tip reef sharks roam. Marvel at bumphead parrot fish and graceful eagle rays, alongside stately napoleons and serene turtles.

## Lily Rock

35 mins, our favorite manta cleaning station, located just inside the Ari Atoll, North-East of Nova Maldives. Beautiful topography with two reefs separated by a sandy bottom in which sits the main cleaning station.

## Vilamendhoo Thila




# Broken Rock


# Kuda Rah Thila


# Noo Giri




# Thinfushi Ethere Thila


# Kudhi Maa Wreck




# Madivaru Rangali Manta Point

# Maamigili Corner






