
At Six Senses Laamu;

- The Sea Hub of Environmental Learning in Laamu (SHELL), the new state-of-art marine discovery center on sunset beach, features a large exhibition space, a research lab for the Maldives Underwater Initiative (MUI) team, a marine-focused kids' space for our Junior Marine Biology (JMB) program and an innovative presentation room including virtual reality and cinema space.
- The Retreat, three-bedroom villa (with possible fourth room add-on) with a private lap pool that reaches out over the lagoon.
- Added private pools to the remaining beach villas which do not already have pools, meaning our property will become an all-pool villa product from a beach villa perspective.





Where is Six Senses Laamu located?









Lagoon Water Villa

- Panoramic upper deck and viewing platform with daybeds



Sunset Laamu Water Villa


- Located only on Pier-A, further away from the main island offering guaranteed sunset and uninterrupted ocean views

- Panoramic upper deck and viewing platform with daybeds






Lagoon Beach Villa with Pool

4 Units – size 126 sq.m.


- Located further out on the jetty offering extended ocean views

Laamu Water Villa with Pool


- Located at the end of the jetties, furthest away from the main island offering uninterrupted ocean views

Family Beach Villa with Pool


6 units – size 253 sq.m.

Sunset Laamu Water Villa with Pool


- Located at the end of Pier-A, furthest away from the main island offering uninterrupted ocean views

1 unit – size 285 sq.m.


- Private access to the beach

- Two fully furnished bedrooms, one with an additional adjacent children's bedroom, all with individual bathrooms

- Villa faces toward the ocean with uninterrupted views to the horizon
- Extensive standalone living room with dining table



The Retreat

1 unit – size 1,728 sq.m.

- Private 20 m lap pool
- Direct access to the lagoon and beach access
- Extensive outdoor dining deck, relaxation area with sun loungers and over-water hammocks
- Three fully furnished bedrooms with private bathrooms, one with an additional children's room
- Available with the addition of a fourth fully furnished bedroom and private bathroom, facing toward the turquoise lagoon
- Extensive standalone living room with dining table and kitchen
- Facing towards the turquoise lagoon

Sea Hub of Environmental Learning in Laamu (SHELL)

"Step into the ocean without getting your feet wet"

Designed for education and immersive marine conservation experiences. It is also home to our Maldives Underwater Initiative (MUI).

- Central exhibition space that invites you to explore the colorful and vibrant local marine life
- Marine laboratory
- Cinema room
- Kids' zone; virtual and augmented reality technologies
- The central gallery, also called the Tank, a high-resolution LED display floor and five educational viewing booths for kids and adults













MUI

- Six Senses Laamu has the biggest marine biologists team in Maldives (12 members) and they strive to inspire guests, fellow hosts and local communities by promoting education and awareness of the marine environment.
- MUI is an initiative by Six Senses Laamu in partnership with three NGOs: **Blue Marine Foundation, the Manta Trust and the Olive Ridley Project**. The mission is to lead the tourism industry in the Maldives by undertaking meaningful marine conservation focused around the three pillars of research, education and community.
- MUI was also honored with the 'Best for Wildlife and Nature Conservation' Award for its #ProtectMaldivesSeagrass campaign at the World Travel Market's Responsible Tourism Awards.
- The Marine Team conducts complimentary guided snorkeling, sunset dolphin cruise, evening presentations at SHELL, reef clean ups and Kids Club Presentations.
- Marine Biologists join our dive trips to give information on mantas, turtles, corals, and fish life and answer any related questions.










Six Senses Laamu Junior Marine Biology Program

What sets Six Senses Laamu apart from the 144 other resorts in the Maldives is its dedication to sustainability and marine conservation. Forming MUI was a natural progression of the resort's goals to protect and conserve Laamu's unique environment.



The Manta Trust is a UK-registered charity that coordinates global mobulid research and conservation efforts. Since 2014, the Manta Trust have been working in Laamu to study the local manta ray population and to educate guests and the local community.



Blue Marine Foundation (BLUE) exists to combat overfishing and the destruction of biodiversity by delivering practical conservation solutions, including the creation of large-scale marine reserves. Since 2016, the team has been working with the community towards better fisheries management and improving the resilience of Laamu's reefs.



Olive Ridley Project is on a mission to remove ghost nets from the ocean; to rescue and rehabilitate injured sea turtles, and educate the world about the ghost nets. Since April 2018, a sea turtle biologist from the organisation has been stationed at Six Senses Laamu.

- The Alchemy workshops will offer the Guest the opportunity to learn, to experiment, to personalize, tailor-made their skin care products at home.







