CONCEPT

LOCATION

The Barefoot is nestled within an almost pristine forest on the local island of Hanimaadhoo, located in the preserved deep North of the Maldives. This 4-star Eco Hotel is conveniently connected to Malé International Airport by numerous daily 45-minute flights. Surrounded by dense vegetation, the resort offers both privacy and the chance to experience untouched nature and the authentic, natural beauty of the Maldives, all while enjoying the comforts of a charming accommodation. A private half-mile sandy beach and a turquoise lagoon frame the hotel, inviting guests to enjoy an authentic and relaxing holiday at exceptional value.

ACCOMMODATION

The Barefoot Eco Hotel offers a total of 64 rooms, all fully furnished to a high standard across two-story buildings with 4 rooms each:

20 Beach Front rooms located on the ground floor with direct access to the white sandy beach. These large rooms, approximately 50 sqm including the veranda, come with either double or twin beds and can accommodate up to 4 people.

20 Ocean View rooms situated on the upper floor, these rooms offer a spectacular sea view. They are also spacious, around 50 sqm including the terrace, with double or twin beds, and a maximum occupancy of 4 people.

Family rooms (2 connecting beach front or ocean view rooms) are also available. Maximum occupancy 6 people.

Additionally, 24 rooms are all located on the ground floor:

12 Beachside rooms these charming rooms are furnished with elegant materials and contemporary amenities, featuring a spacious private patio equipped with a traditional Maldivian swing. Located just steps away from our endless white beach, they offer a partial sea view. Maximum occupancy is 3 people.

12 Seaside rooms Affordable and comfortable accommodation (44 sqm including the veranda), nicely furnished. They are part of the same complex with a sandy inner courtyard, just few steps away from the beach. Maximum occupancy 3 people.

THE BAREFOOT CONSERVATION CENTER

All our marine excursions are carefully designed to minimize environmental impact while contributing to biodiversity monitoring and supporting the local community's economy. During turtle, manta ray, and dolphin monitoring excursions, guests have the unique opportunity to actively participate in data collection, assisting our marine biologist in monitoring the population distribution of these fascinating animals. A snorkeling trip by boat is offered once a week.

- **Dolphin Watching Trip by Boat:** Enjoy an exciting boat trip to observe various dolphin species while adhering to a respectful code of conduct to protect these magnificent creatures.
- **Manta Monitoring Trip by Boat:** Participate in a manta monitoring trip by boat, where you'll have the chance to swim alongside majestic mantas.
- **Turtle Monitoring Trip by Boat:** Join a dedicated boat trip to observe and interact with turtles in their natural habitat, providing an immersive and educational experience.
- **Desert Island and Sandbank Trip:** Escape to a secluded desert island for a romantic getaway, where you can relax in an untouched paradise and enjoy the serenity of nature.

The session includes an introduction, breathing practice, warm-up, standing and seated sequences, and meditation. It is designed for anyone looking to escape the routine, stress, and worries of modern daily life.

THE BAREFOOT DIVING CENTER

Our diving center ensures the highest standards of quality and professionalism, offering complete sets of rental equipment (for an additional charge), including BCDs, masks, snorkels, fins, wetsuits, and dive computers. We provide customized services suitable for both adults and children. We offer PADI and SSI courses at all levels, including "NITROX" or "ENRICHED AIR DIVER" courses, as well as free "TRY DIVES." The azure blue waters are warm, and the variety of dive sites is stunning, with 20-30 sites reachable by boat within 40 minutes. These areas are renowned for their abundance of large marine animals, such as sharks and manta rays, along with a rich diversity of hard and soft corals and fish of all sizes and colors.

OUR ECO COMMITMENT

The Barefoot Eco Hotel received GSTC (Global Sustainable Tourism Council) certification in 2021, recognizing its commitment and dedication to environmental protection and sustainable hospitality. The Italo-Swiss management team and all staff members work daily to enhance both the environmental and social conditions of the island.



- **Sustainable Wood:** All buildings are constructed using wood sourced from responsibly managed forests.
- **Plastic Reduction:** Water is bottled in reusable glass, minimizing environmental impact.
- **Beach Cleaning:** Our marine biologist, in collaboration with the dive center, regularly organizes beach and underwater clean-up activities to protect the surrounding ecosystems. These efforts help keep the environment clean and raise guest awareness about ocean pollution.
- **Zero-Kilometer Garden:** We offer fresh fruits and vegetables directly from our garden, with locally sourced, zero-kilometer products.
- **Local Sourcing:** We prioritize purchasing products from Hanimaadhoo Island and nearby islands.
- **Sustainable Monitoring:** The conservation team arranges responsible tourist activities, such as excursions focused on dolphins and manta rays, to explore the ocean while respecting wildlife.
- **Heat Exchanger:** We use renewable energy to heat shower water.
- **Bio-Pest Control:** We use eco-friendly mosquito traps to avoid chemical products.
- **Promotion of Local Culture:** We offer land excursions to explore local villages and immerse in Maldivian culture.
- **Development of Specific Programs:** We promote environmental education in the local school and offer frequent internships throughout the year.
