

2. Fitness Families


Successful families with older children, who have an active lifestyle and focus on their physical and mental wellbeing.

Experienced travellers who have 'been there and done that' and come to value a different kind of luxury where less is more.




Amelia, 36 Low-key Luxurian

When they travel, they choose destinations with a focus on wellness – places where the girls can go to body balance classes and the boys can opt for more targeted workouts.




Finn, 42

The island's tropical beauty, wide beaches and lush vegetation are the dominant features, with contrasting materials used to frame the serene scenery.


Wooden tables are decorated with crystal glasses, wicker seating areas are lit with large chandeliers, and earthenware pots are filled with sublime soaps.

The colour palette takes its inspiration from earthy tones of grey, beige and terracotta, elevated with shining metals that add a heavenly twinkle.










2 PROGRAMMING

Humble Hallmarks

The branded differentiators at Villa Haven are the experiences, products and services that make a stay at this Humble Heaven special to its guests.

They are the interactions that the Simple Sybarites will remember and cherish from their holiday.

These branded differentiators have been named Humble Hallmarks as the moments that define a stay at Villa Haven. The following examples will demonstrate how the resort concept will be activated on property. These ideas have been selected by the Villa Haven Island Innovation Team and are undergoing development, so finer details are subject to change.

I. HEALING HAVEN

Where healing and hospitality come together

Sublime Sparkling Serene

In a busy world, it's tough to slow down and unwind when our minds are always connected and running a mile a minute. Here at Villa Haven we understand that for many people this stress doesn't just evaporate the moment you arrive at your holiday destination. So, to accelerate the process of decompression, we have designed our spacious lobby to help guests loosen up and feel the healing spirit of Haven from the very start. The space is not just for checking in and out, it's an aesthetically arresting and vibrant hub filled with health promoting activities that guests will want to visit throughout their stay. It is designed around mindfulness, wellness and self-enhancement, and conceived to promote a deeper connection with oneself and the elements. We call it our Healing Haven.

Over here, an aerial yoga class called 'Yogaroma' is taking place on intricately woven hanging silk drapes. Over there, complimentary hand massages take place, ready to work your pressure points into gentle relaxation. In a traditional Henna Lounge sits a local artist, available to adorn and decorate guests' bodies with symbols of love, joy, and spiritual awakening.

A lavish wooden Herb Counter displays small muslin pockets and dried herbs on its busy worktop, ready for Wellness Worshippers to create their own fragrant pouches to add into luggage.

All around are remedy stations bursting with concoctions and potions to revive tired souls. Dhivehi beys is also on offer – an ancient Maldivian herbal medicine, which Villa Haven has preserved. Inspired by a renowned Maldivian medicine healer and combined with modern techniques, it helps to relieve ailments such as migraines, fluid retention and muscle tension.

There's an Ayurvedic Avenue too, where an Ayurvedic doctor charts guests' dosha and records their improving wellness throughout their stay. Together, these reflect the Maldives' history of ancestral healing and its place in Villa Haven life.

A Sleep Solutions Station provides everything there is to know about sleep. Books, magazines and specific remedies are on offer. Guests can come here at any point to talk about their poor sleep and to seek advice. At the Tea Bar, loose-leaf teas from across the globe are displayed in jars on wooden shelves that rise to the ceiling, with a library ladder to reach them.

A Conversations Corner offers daily educational talks on subjects ranging from wellness to diving expeditions. This spot doubles as an extra library, with shelves brimming full of magazines and books. Guest Mentor Stations are situated at three corners, with their designated staff members always ready to assist.

On leaving Villa Haven, guests will forever remember this incredible hub of pursuits. They will never forget the wonder and thrill to their senses the moment they enter the hall, nor the warmth of the Maldivian welcome and care offered here during their stay.







2. HUSK

Primitive cooking with flare and flair

Raw Sublime Sparkling

The Husk concept restaurant pays homage to the simple and the stripped back, serving a variety of dishes inspired by the celebration of fire.

This beach eatery has its own mantra: fire ignites the feelings of human warmth and desire. It conjures alchemy, mystery and possibility. The soaring flames are the focal point of the restaurant, with the Husk fire pit positioned centre stage for Confident Couples to enjoy front row seats to the chefs' culinary flair. Guests are invited to learn about the different and exciting ways to cook with fire: it's a fully interactive experience.

The restaurant is positioned next to the ocean so that Simple Sybarites have the best view of the azure waters as they witness raw ingredients transform over the flames. It has a large canopy structure on the sand with rustic screens that can be pulled down when the ocean winds are high, ensuring Confident Couples a cosy evening no matter the weather.

Candlelight and low level seating on cushions and hand-woven rugs add to the intimate atmosphere. As they relish Husk's wild flavours, Wellness Worshippers eat on beautifully sculpted crockery made from coconuts.

There are three operational areas that include a rotisserie, two coconut husk-fired chargrills, and hanging cast iron potjie pots. A blackboard menu offers a selection of delicacies that showcase regionally-inspired dishes. On the rotisserie, whole birds and legs of lamb are seared to perfection. The rotisserie cooking features Food Concept 360's world-famous coconut herbed chickens.

The large chargrills are dedicated to the finest meat and seafood. Coconut husks, abundant on the island, are not just a sustainable biofuel but also add to the flavour and longevity of the fire. In cast iron pots Maldivian style curries and stews bubble away, releasing aromas of local spices and herbs. The excellence and simplicity of the dishes will leave Low-key Luxurians convinced that less is indeed more. They savour rustic, smoked flavours of fresh fish slow-cooked over red coals, or hung marinated meats seared to perfection on the giant grills. Husk also offers desserts straight from the fire – delicious sweet treats as simple as roasted peaches drizzled with honey.

In all, Husk creates an intimate environment that stimulates the senses and invites Simple Sybarites to enjoy an experience they will want to come back for over and over again.





3. SPELLBINDING SHOWS AND TALES

Imaginative storytelling around the campfire

Raw Resourceful Serene

After dinner, a group of Simple Sybarites congregate casually around a fire pit on the beach to take part in Villa Haven's serene evening ritual of cross-cultural and Holhuashi storytelling.

Laid out in a circle on the sand around the crackling campfire are woven throws, big soft pillows and giant bean-bags for Confident Couples to snuggle up on. This comfy seating invites guests to recline, relax and enjoy the stories with their eyes closed or looking up at the stars. A wider circle of fire torches stand in the sand, marking the creative space and a circle of trust – a safe and liberating space.

Villa Haven sparks the evening off with an exquisitely performed and immersive shadow puppet show. The puppets entertain, uplift and educate in a series of performances that dramatise historical events and Maldivian myths, enlivening the tales with engrossing themes and beguiling humour.

Team Members tell enchanting myths, preserved throughout the generations from the forefathers. There is no stage: the storytellers interact and mingle with the group in a way that embraces them in a shared experience.

The evening is filled with snippets of childhood memories, global histories, native songs, philosophies and altogether good vibes. As it listens, the audience is served toddy and other traditional drinks. Passed around with fresh cookies, guests may also enjoy a selection of warm drinks like mojito teas, Baileys hot chocolate, mango mulled wine and classic Irish coffee.

4. GREAT OUTDOORS

A breath of fresh air and sense of space

Reserved Sublime Serene Villa Haven's gardens hide surprising pursuits to calm the mind and soothe the soul. Rustic local hammocks hang from the trees in peaceful spots.

Tucked away in hidden nooks and crannies, dreaming benches are accessorised with rugs crafted by local weavers.

Wellness Worshippers tell the time by the Silent Clock, a bespoke armillary commissioned from an international sculptor.

Close to the natural Produce Table, which brims with complimentary refreshments, Low-key Luxurians find a vintage cabinet well stocked with books on flora and fauna.

As night falls, the island's grounds sparkle in to life. Banyan trees bedecked in fairy lights are the backdrop for private dinners and poetry readings.

5. THE CLAY CLUB

Feeling elemental with clay and light

Raw Resourceful Working with clay is deeply meditative, forcing people to temper their pace of life, and to think and experience more slowly, deeply and sensually.

Above all, The Clay Club is a place for calm; an escapist environment that nurtures a precious sense of community. The Club welcomes guests of any ability to practise this ancient art.

Dancing shadows, formed by shafts of light from apertures in the roof, contribute to an unearthly mood. Incense smoulders and world music fills the air. The master potter shows Simple Sybarites how to hand-mould clay or throw on a wheel.

By modelling with clay made from uniquely textured island materials, including sand, shells and dry palm leaves, Deep Sea Divers awaken their imaginations and experience a new form of deeply therapeutic transformation through touch and pressure.

It's a memorable experience which also leaves a memory in physical form – the perfect souvenir, which Villa Haven will carefully wrap to ensure it makes the journey home in one piece.







6. RISE AND SHINE

A ceremony of morning salutation

Reserved Sublime Serene From time immemorial, sunrise has been the focus of worship, thanks-giving and ritual. At Villa Haven, this spiritual moment is honoured with a beautiful ritual, rich in meaning and mindfulness.

To mark the dawning of the new day, Simple Sybarites congregate on the sand to witness the rising sun. Participants are given special sustainable cotton kimonos to wear for the ritual.

The Low-key Luxurians listen to a Team Member in the role of Katheeb (Island Chief) who will lightly blow a Sangu shell to signify the commencement of the ceremony. This performative ritual enhances this profound moment with traditional Maldivian solemnity. Candles are lit, flickering in glass jars against the morning light and nestled in the sand to mark out the sacred space.

Wellness Worshippers are introduced to sound healing exercises and stretching routines and it becomes a ritual that guests will want to repeat daily, lending a spiritual structure to their new island life. 7. EDEN'S GARDEN

Heaven Scent in Eden's Garden

Raw Resourceful Suhlime Eden's Garden is a perfumed enclave in which Simple Sybarites learn how to open their noses and make, bottle and name their own fragrances.

Suffused with scents, the carefully curated garden is filled with exotic plants of varying colours, textures and fragrance to delight all the senses and create a year-round natural perfumery.

The walled garden is also used by the chefs to supply the kitchen with many herbs, such as mint, rosemary and thyme, all grown in terracotta pots.

Guided by Villa Haven's expert perfumer, students are educated in the aromatherapeutic benefits of different herbs and learn about the core 'fragrance families' and their defining characteristics.

In understanding the structure of perfumes they will learn to distinguish base notes from the top notes, along with the heart notes that linger on after the top notes have faded.

Working from a series of base oils, guests personalise fragrances using a range of exotic essences, resulting in bespoke soaps, oils and shampoos made from natural ingredients. Free to take home is a 15ml bottle of guests' unique fragrance – available nowhere else, with the formula kept safe by Villa Haven in its Heaven Scent Library.





8. TODDY TAPPER TRICKS

An authentic guided tour with the Toddy Tapper

Raw Resourceful Sublime In days gone by it was the backbone of livelihoods, but has died away with modern times. Villa Haven preserves and nurtures this unique and historical occupation, requiring the artful skill of being able to climb a coconut palm.

The toddy is a sweet ambrosia that contains beneficial properties such as zinc, iron, antioxidants and inulin.

Simple Sybarites are invited to appreciate this indigenous skill through a guided experience with a mystical Toddy Tapper, in which they can taste the fresh toddy drink in the undergrowth of Villa Haven's palm groves only metres from where the sweet nectar is created.

The Toddy Tapper scales the massive palms with effortless grace. Hanging from his waist is a ceramic jug and two sharpened sickle knives. In an awe-inspiring fashion, he taps the tree to extract the nectar. While gently beating the flower, he ties a container beneath it to catch the juice, then descends back down carrying his batch of fresh toddy.

Low-key Luxurians can choose between a morning or an evening tour – either is an unmissable opportunity to celebrate this rich Maldivian tradition.

Coconuts are also a fundamental element of Maldivian life. The Toddy Tapper will tell the Wellness Worshippers all about the hidden benefits of coconuts, sharing his tricks and expertise while picking them along the way.

An unmissable opportunity, this authentic experience will celebrate Maldivian culture and pay homage to its colourful roots and traditions.

9. GAMERS' DOWNTIME

Absorbing analogue games


Raw Resourceful

In the Lagoon Bar, an international games library houses a collection of nostalgic childhood classics, as well as Maldivian favourites such as Ohvalh.

Guests from all around the world are able to connect, bond and teach the rules of the games they grew up with to fellow Simple Sybarites.

Every game is an absorbingly time-consuming form of analogue entertainment to be played individually, as a couple or in groups. Displayed behind the bar, each one has a leader board that provokes conversations between the Deep Sea Divers and Wellness Worshippers, adding just a little element of competition to the proceedings.

Team Members also host interactive group game sessions to practise for the weekly championships, focusing on specific games. Simple Sybarites are invited to take part in this competition, known as Gamers' Show Down at Sun Down, set against the stunning backdrop of the Lagoon.







10. HEAVENLY MANNA

The basics of life made heavenly



3 MAIN RESTAURANT

A Culinary Journey

Villa Haven's main restaurant offers breakfast, lunch and dinner in a modern market-style setting with vintage cookbooks, vibrant herb walls and colourful spice racks.

Boasting six international cuisines, guests are taken on a culinary journey around some of the world's most exciting flavours.



TAPAS

Guests can explore the Ayurvedic tapas stage, with foods based on the traditional system of holistic medicine that is native to India. Ayurvedic cooking principles respect the importance of each of the six tastes – sweet, sour, salty, bitter, astringent and pungent – for their balancing properties.

ORIENTAL

The Pan-Asian stage combines global favourites from China, Japan, Thailand and Korea. Guests can gorge on vegetarian dumplings, tempura prawns, fragrant jasmine rice and stir-fried noodles.

MALDIVIAN

The Maldivian stage is based on three local ingredients and their infinite fusions – coconut, tuna, and starches that contain grains and vegetables. Honouring local cuisine, plenty of fresh chillies will be celebrated in these dishes. Vegetable, fish or meat curries will be rich with spices and exotic flavours.

SEAFOOD

Villa Haven's seafood kitchen holds the ethos that fish should be king of the plate, and that delicate cooking is best. The seafood stage offers the freshest catch of the day either steamed, grilled or barbecued, served alongside simple sauces of local herbs and spices. The raw bar includes oysters and clams for guests seeking something lighter.

MEDITERRANEAN

With live cooking to whet appetites, the Italian stage features wood burning pizza ovens, fusion toppings, gnocchi, risottos and perfectly *al dente* homemade pastas.

DESSERT

For a change in palate, the pudding stage is an indulgent affair of ice cream, sorbets and classic desserts. Pastry chefs lovingly prepare handmade chocolates using the finest cocoa beans from France, Belgium and Switzerland, as well as popular choices such as Nutella waffles, warm chocolate fondant, creme brûlée, flavoured cheesecakes and lemon tarts.
