Step-by-Step Guide: Kling Al Video Creation Worksheet

Part 1 – Finding/Creating Your Storefront Photo

Step 1 – Find, take, or create a photo of your storefront

- If you are creating a photo, or if you want to add details to an existing photo, using an AI like Chat GPT or Copilot works well
- You can also use Kling AI for this, though Chat GPT and Copilot can complete /this task for free, where Kling AI will require you to use credits

Step 2 – If creating or adding details to an already existing photo, you will need to create and insert prompt into the AI you want to use

- Your prompt should include details like subject matter, size, colors, props, lighting, angle, and anything else you want it to add
- If adding details to a photo, you will also need to upload the photo to the Al
- If you don't like your first outcome, try again, it may take a few tries to create what you want

Step 3 - After finding or creating a photo you like, download it to your computer

- Make sure the photo size is the same size you will want your video to be
- Video sizes include 16:9 for YouTube, 9:16 for Instagram reels, and 1:1 for Instagram posts

Part 2 – Create A Grand Opening Advertisement Flyer

Step 1 – Choose the AI you want to use

- Both Copilot and ChatGPT work very well
- You could also use Canva's AI, but it has less variety in design

Step 2 – Create a prompt to put in the AI of your choice

 Your prompt should include things like opening date and time, store name, address, socials, your logo, and other details you would like to add

- Also, your prompt should include design element like colors, themes, styles, and other details you would like the AI to include
- If you don't like your first outcome, try again, it may take a couple tries to get a flyer you like

Step 3 – After creating a flyer you like, download it to your computer

- Make sure the photo size is the same size you will want your video to be
- Video sizes include 16:9 for YouTube, 9:16 for Instagram Reels, and 1:1 for Instagram posts

Part 3 – Create An Advertisement Video with Kling Al

Step 1 – Open Kling AI and Navigate to the *Video* tab on the side of the screen, then the *Image to Video* tab at the top of the screen

- You can also choose which version of Kling you want to use at the top of the screen
- Each version focuses on certain qualities and costs different amounts of credits
- You can use the same prompt in different versions to see the difference in outcomes

Step 2 – In the small rectangular *Start* box, add your storefront picture, and in the *End* box, add your advertisement flyer

Reminder that these should be the same size as your video will be

Step 3 – Create a prompt, then add it to the *Prompt* box under the *Frames* box

- You can create your prompt using Chat GPT, Copilot, or DeepSeek, which is built into Kling AI and can format your prompt easily for Kling AI
- Your prompt can be something like this:

A handheld camera follows customers walking toward the store entrance, passing under red and blue balloon columns. As they walk into the store, the view dissolves into the final poster composition - the blue shirt gleaming under soft studio lights while animated golden sparkles dance around the shopping bag.

- Make sure to include details that describe parts of your video including the scene, subjects, and atmosphere
- You can also add details describing the camera and its movement to help improve your prompt

Step 4 – Add and check your final details

- Scroll down to the *Sound Effects* box and describe what sound or music you would like, whether it is slow, fast, upbeat, happy, calm, etc.
- At the bottom, check your video is the length and size you want it to be
- Kling AI allows for 5 or 10 second videos and you can pick which of the three video sizes matches with your photo and flyer

Part 4 – Finishing Touches

Step 1 – Once everything is how you want you can generate your video using the green *Generate* button

• It may take a couple minutes for your video to generate

Step 2 – Watch your video and determine if you like the outcome

- If the video made is not what you are looking for, try again, it may take multiple tries to get the video you envisioned
- Once you like the video that was generated, you can download it using the download button under your video

Step 3 – You are all done and can use your video to advertise your business!
