We need your help to keep our parish running smoothly during the construction of the new 900 sq. ft. meeting room!

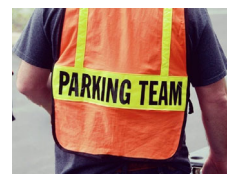
To ensure everyone can find a spot safely and minimize congestion, we are asking for **Parish Parking Volunteers** to help direct traffic before and after weekend Masses.

REFLECTION: At his baptism the heavens were opened and the Spirit descended upon Jesus, anointing him as Messiah. 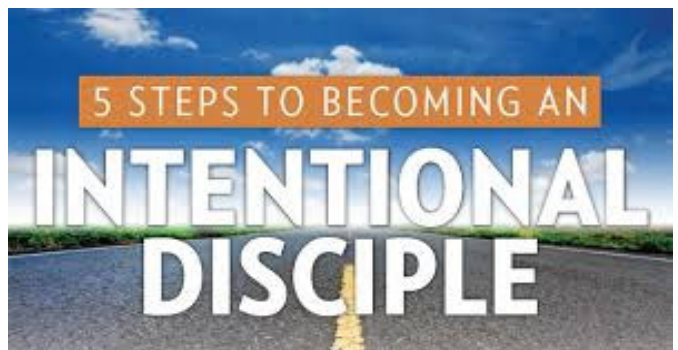

Do YOU Follow Christ?

Last year I was part of a 15 week workshop offered by the Office of Parish Life at the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, called *Forming Intentional Disciples*.

I came away with some thoughts about our community here at San Roque. We have a strong community of faith but how do we share it? How can we grow our faith community OUTSIDE the walls at Sunday Mass? What do Fr. Bruce and I need in order to equip and support this community in their mission as people who intentionally follow Jesus Christ in the world today?

From Seeker to Disciple

In her work on *Forming Intentional Disciples*, Sherry Weddell notes a striking reality: many of us are "sacramentalized" but not yet "evangelized." We may attend Mass faithfully, yet we have never made a conscious, personal decision to follow Jesus as a disciple.

Discipleship is not a byproduct of sitting in a pew; it is an intentional "yes" to a relationship with Christ that reorders our entire lives. Like any relationship it must be tended to—talk with Jesus (pray), trust in Jesus, live our lives the way Jesus commanded us to live (love God with our whole self and love our neighbor as our self). Reorder our lives around Jesus—what books do we read, what shows/movies do we watch, what apps are on our phones, what do we reach for 1st thing in the morning, and the last thing we do at night? As we begin 2026, let us reflect on our own journey. Have we dropped our nets to follow Him, or are we simply observers of the faith? Moving from "cultural Catholicism" to intentional discipleship is the first step in renewing our parish. It starts with a simple, private prayer: "Lord, I am yours. Teach me how to follow you."

As a safe adult, you have tremendous power to make a profound difference for children – not only by recognizing and responding to unsafe situations, but also by teaching children about their rights to safety and creating environments where they can speak up and get help. There are skills we can teach to children to help them to better protect themselves when faced with tough situations like child sexual abuse or grooming experiences where their boundaries are violated. It is important to make sure children know this, so they don't feel guilt or shame if abuse does happen, to them or to a friend. 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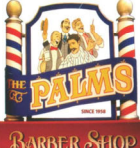
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
