We need your help to keep our parish running smoothly during the construction of the new 900 sq. ft. meeting room!

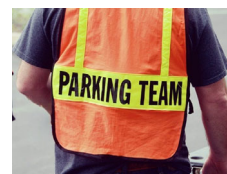
To ensure everyone can find a spot safely and minimize congestion, we are asking for **Parish Parking Volunteers** to help direct traffic before and after weekend Masses.

In all of these instances do we hear Jesus' refrain: repent? Turn from ourselves toward those in need. Turn from darkness to light.

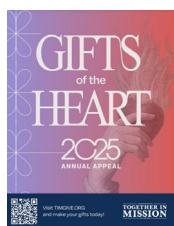

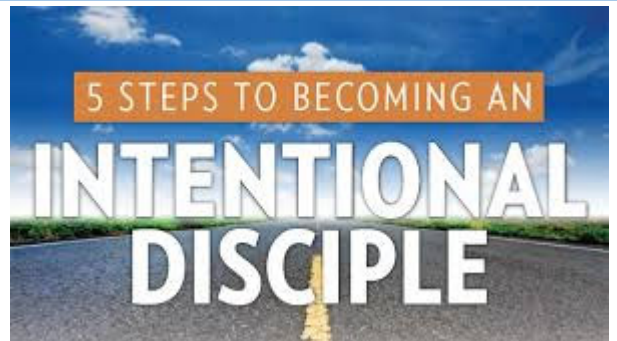

Do YOU Follow Christ? (3rd in a series of 5)

Last year I was part of a 15 week workshop offered by the Office of Parish Life at the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, called *Forming Intentional Disciples*.

I came away with some thoughts about our community here at San Roque. We have a strong community of faith but how do we share it? How can we grow our faith community OUTSIDE the walls at Sunday Mass? What do Fr. Bruce and I need in order to equip and support this community in their mission as people who intentionally follow Jesus Christ in the world today? - Noël



Article 3: The Five Thresholds of Conversion

Conversion is rarely a lightning-bolt moment; it is a journey. Sherry Weddell identifies five thresholds that people typically cross before becoming intentional disciples:

Initial Trust: A person has a positive association with a believer or the Church.

Spiritual Curiosity: A person is intrigued by Jesus or the faith.

Spiritual Openness: A person is open to the possibility of personal change.

Spiritual Seeking: A person is actively searching for God and counting the cost of commitment.

Intentional Discipleship: The person makes a conscious decision to follow Jesus.

Our job as a parish is to meet people where they are. If we try to push a "Seeker" into "Discipleship" too fast, they may retreat. This week, let us pray for the grace to recognize which threshold our friends and family are standing on, and walk with them patiently.

Safeguard The Children

Did you know?

What does grooming look like?

In practice, grooming relies on secrecy. Groomers use secrets to bind their child victims to them, starting with small secrets and working up to harmful ones, like abusive behaviors. Predators often use bribery ("I'll let you stay up late and watch TV if you let me do this."), threats ("I'll hurt you if you tell."), and withdrawal of affection ("I won't like you if you tell anyone the truth.") to keep children from disclosing abuse. Families should establish a "no secrets" rule, and never ask children to keep secrets from their parents or trusted adults. 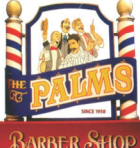
