REFLECTION & MEDITATION:

One way to approach the Beatitudes is in terms of their being descriptions of identity rather than moral demands. The Beatitudes embody a radically alternative vision of our Society. This is how the kingdom of heaven is at hand: that we appreciate that we are in ourselves are blessed. Blessed is who we are in Christ. God indeed calls us to blessedness.

(Living Liturgy, p. 54)

“The gospels and epistles frequently remind Christians to be gentle. They should seek to resolve conflicts peacefully, act with kindness, speak courteously—in short, love their neighbors as they love themselves. Such gentleness comes when Christians realize that despite all their sins, God loves them. The balance of gentleness and strength is learned in the schools of prayer and experience. Gentleness is not passivity or spinelessness. Strength is not uncontrolled rage or stoic coldness. Determining when to be gentle and when to be forceful should be the subject of our prayerful discernment. We are called to be gently strong, and strongly gentle.

Bible Study!


Join us for our wildly successful year-round bi-weekly Bible Study that meets every other

Do YOU Follow Christ? (4th in a series of 5)

Article 4: You Are Gifted for Mission

Every baptized Catholic has been given "charisms"—supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit intended to be used for the benefit of others. As Sherry Weddell teaches, your charisms are clues to your mission.

Whether it is the gift of hospitality, teaching, intercessory prayer, or administration, these are not just natural talents; they are tools given by God to build His Kingdom. When we use our charisms, we feel a sense of energy and purpose because we are doing what we were created to do. This year, we invite you to move from "volunteerism" to "apostleship." Instead of just filling a slot on a schedule, ask: "What gifts has the Holy Spirit given me to serve this community?" Discerning your charisms is essential to living as a missionary disciple.
