

Pray for Marriages

*By yourself, or with a group of people.
Commit to pray for marriages every day during National Marriage Week: those who WANT to get married, those who are recently engaged, those experiencing struggles in their marriage, those who have entered the empty nest, those who are experiencing the loss of a spouse, our young adults who are beginning to date, and those who are facing trauma or major life transition in their home and lives.*

REFLECTION: The lights in a city create a glow in the sky that can be seen from miles away. However, a light can be hidden—put under a bushel; the light still shines, but its light is blanketed, covered over, kept from doing what it is meant to do. When Jesus says, “You are the light of the world,” he is saying that we can choose to cover over the grace that is given us. We can choose to ignore who we are called to be—beloved adopted sons and daughters—and act of “out of character.” Then our actions do not square up with who we are. By such choices we compromise both identity and mission. We must live who we are. Identity and mission cannot be separated. *(Living Liturgy, p.58)*


Bible Study!
