Lent is a time to listen to Jesus, “who calls us to repentance and a change of heart.” It is a time to reflect on God’s Word about loving our enemies and being peacemakers, about proclaiming liberty to captives and letting the oppressed go free, about being the salt of the earth and the light of the world, about being perfect just as our heavenly Father is perfect. It is a time to be quiet and listen to the God “who has saved us and has called us to a holy life.” It is a time to become a “great nation” through whom “all the communities of the earth shall find blessing.”

Jesus perfected revelation by fulfilling it through his whole work of making himself present and manifesting himself: through his words and deeds, his signs and wonders, but especially through his death and glorious resurrection from the dead and final sending of the Spirit of truth.

Moreover, he confirmed with divine testimony what revelation proclaimed: that God is with us to free us from the darkness of sin and death, and to raise us up to life eternal.

**evening at 6:30pm** in San Roque Church.


We will explore history and meaning, hear musical adaptations, and pray with five familiar Psalms.

Please invite family and friends from all walks of life and faith traditions.



## From Performance to Presence: Beyond the "Earning" Mindset

One of the greatest hurdles in our Lenten journey is the "meritocracy" mindset. We often approach fasting and almsgiving as if we are earning points to get closer to God. But if we are already immersed in the Divine, then our "performance" doesn't change God's proximity to us.

God's love is not a reward for our good behavior; it is the very foundation of our existence. We don't fast to make God love us more; we fast to quiet the noise of our egos so we can finally hear the love that has been offered to us since the moment of our birth.

When we stop trying to "attain" God through spiritual gymnastics, we can finally rest in the **awareness** of God. This week, let your Lenten practices be a "letting go" rather than a "taking on." Let go of the need to be perfect, and simply practice being present to the Presence.

**Reflect:** *Am I trying to impress God, or am I willing to simply be loved by God?*

## Safeguard The Children—Did you know?—Children and non-consensual images

Non-consensual intimate imagery (NCII) abuse can affect anyone, regardless of age or gender. In many cases, it can seem like the victim is part of the distribution of his or her own image. Even though a child may provide an intimate picture, children are not capable of understanding the implications or coping with perceived pressure to do so. No matter how an offender obtains intimate material, the victim's fear of images being shared can leave him or her feeling powerless and ashamed. NCII abuse can be used to further manipulate or blackmail a victim into more abusive scenarios.
